

Energy Efficient Wildfire Rebuilding Program

Documents Needed for Program Applications

Refer to the lists below to gather the information you will need to apply for a wildfire rebuilding incentive for a replacement **manufactured home** and/or **heat pump** in the manufactured home.

Manufactured Homes

In addition to basic contact and project information, please gather as much of the following information as possible to get your application started:

- Site address (new and old, as applicable)
- Building permit number
- NEEM Certificate and energy efficiency rating, such as NEEM 1.1, or
- Energy efficient manufactured home replacement program you are in, if any
- Manufactured home retailer name
- Sales agreement
- Total sales price of new manufactured home
- Name of electric utility serving the site
- Year your previous dwelling was built

Heat Pump

Please gather the following if applying for a heat pump incentive (please talk to your contractor for additional guidance about efficiency and sizing):

- Heat pump system type (ductless or ducted)
- Efficiency rating – must be at least 7.6 HSPF2 and 14.3 SEER2
- Invoice showing the following information:
 - Equipment Manufacturer, Model and serial number
 - Cost of the installation and installation date
 - Heat pump incentive amount received from your utility, if any
 - Contractor Company/Installer name and CCB #
 - Contractor email
- Existing heating system type in replacement manufactured home
- Permit number

Note: Depending on where you are in the rebuilding process, you may not have all available information at the time of your initial application (such as a heat pump invoice, if one has not yet been installed). You can log in to update your application when additional information becomes available.
