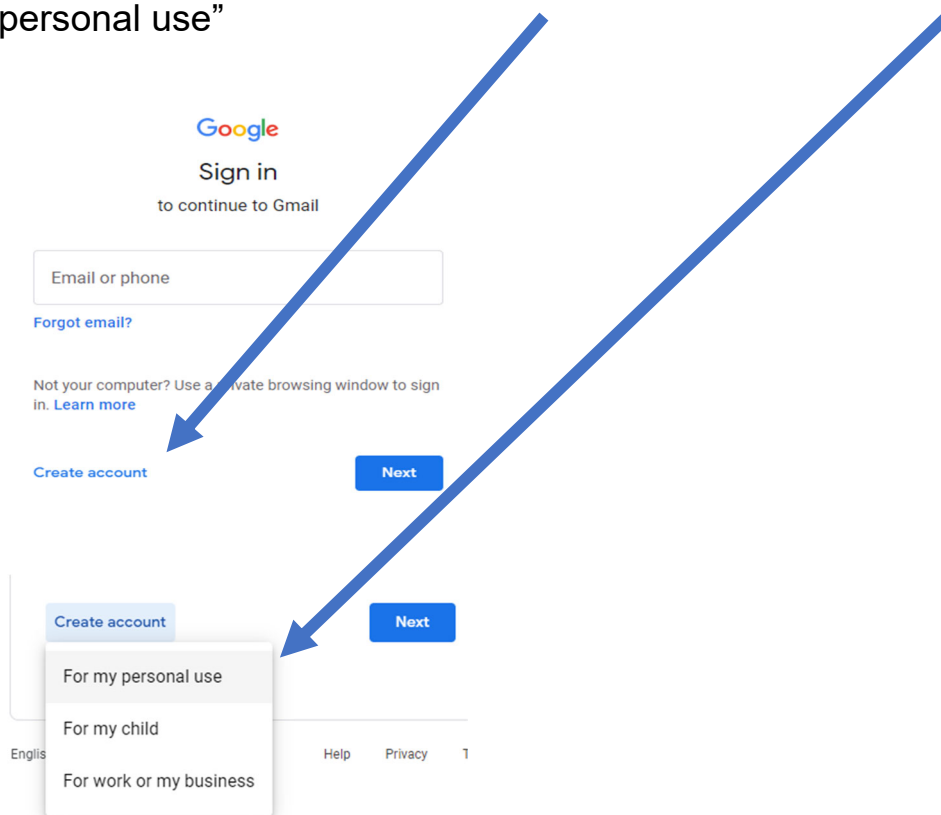


How to Create a Free Email Account

1. [Go to Gmail](#)
2. On the Gmail page click “Create account” and select “For my personal use”

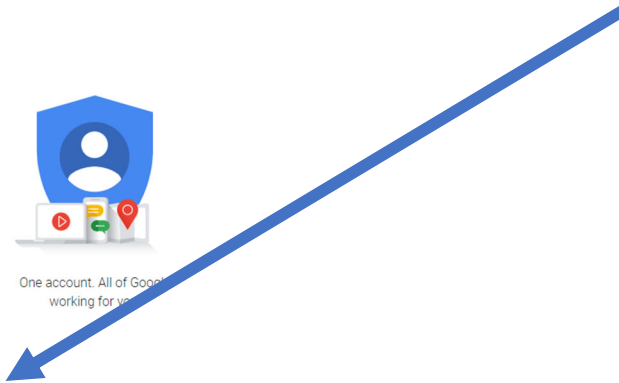

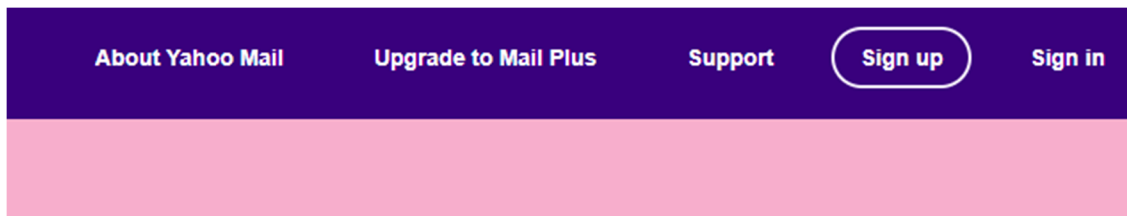


