

High Risk Areas: Inspections and ROW Maintenance



Weather Monitoring:

- National Weather Service
- Local Weather Stations
- Substation Weather Stations
- Various Web Applications

Alternate Recloser Settings:

- Industrial Fire Precaution Levels:
 - IFPL Levels I-II
 - Set predetermined reclosers to "one shot"
 - IFPL Levels III-IV
 - Set predetermined reclosers to Hot Line Tag



Additional Staffing:

- After Hours Monitoring
- After Hours Response
- Vegetation Management Crews
- Holidays and Weekends

Successes:


- Reduced Vegetation Caused Outages

- PSPS


