 - Improving permitting and access to ROWs for vegetation management

- How to address challenge of conducting long-term planning for small COUs when budgeting and short-term issues draw their resources to the immediate future
- Sense of urgency from all parties and all levels of both utilities and land management agencies to make vegetation management a priority
