Subject: New malicious Internet sites to be blocked

Recent virus activity on DHS computers indicates that a new source of infections is originating from visiting certain Internet web sites. Visiting these web sites poses a risk to the information we store on, and transmit via our network. Examples include online gaming, music, and video download sites. In response, DHS will immediately begin blocking access to several additional web sites in order to protect our information assets.
