Subject: Potentially malicious e-mail phishing scam

A recent series of phishing e-mails have been received by DHS employees. Responding to these messages could infect your computer with a virus or compromise the security of your user ID or password.

The content of the message varies, but the intent is to fool you into thinking that our DHS computer technicians have performed maintenance on your e-mail account and that you must verify or provide information to complete the maintenance. Sample pictures of the e-mails are below.

If you receive an e-mail similar to these, **do not reply and do not click on Internet links** contained in the e-mail. When possible, DHS is blocking these e-mails and the web addresses they contain.
