At SH all people are asked at admission if they smoke. RT's use the hospitalization as an opportunity to educate on tobacco and asthma and other chronic diseases. Use videos, one on one education, and a blunt tactic. Reinforce efforts with community cessation support groups.</li> <li>3. Mid Rogue Valley IPA surveyed client base about smoking and quitting. They had a 20% quit rate in their first year and a 21% quit rate in their second year. These are people who have remained tobacco free for over a year.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. What can Medicare do?</li> <li>2. Need for community education around tobacco for school aged children. Maybe use programs such as TATU and Not on Tobacco through the American Lung Association.</li> </ol>
