Data Notes

Eligible Population: Low-income (at or below 250% FPL), uninsured women age 50-64.

Census data at county-level for low-income, uninsured women are not available for the 50-64 age group, therefore the 40-64 age group is used to determine proportion of state total eligible population.

Original Allocation: calculated based on proportion of state total eligible population in county.

Weighted Allocation: calculated from original allocation adjusted based on relative score on several factors (uninsured/unemployment rate, breast and cervical cancer cases per year, and minority population).
