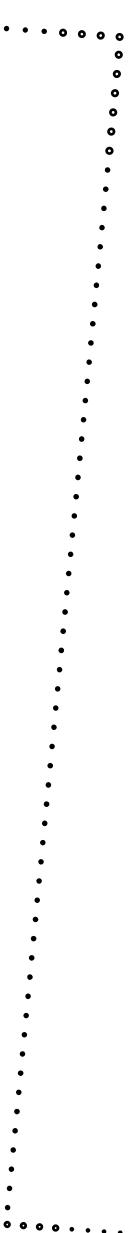

What Is It?

A law was passed in 2001, which requires a system be put into place to see how many Oregon children have diabetes, so the Childhood Diabetes Database was created.

We think the number of children with diabetes is growing rapidly, but there is no way to tell. That's where you come in!

We are requesting your permission to share your child's information with Oregon's Childhood Diabetes Database. Your child's school can only share this information with the database if you give your permission.

Do I Have To Do This?

No, your participation is completely voluntary. There will be no school services affected by whether or not you have your child's information in the database.

If you give your consent,

1) You will be helping to show that diabetes is a growing problem in our state that merits attention.

2) You will also be contacted by the Oregon Diabetes Program and given the opportunity to participate in research projects that may benefit your child.

What Are The Benefits?

The information in the database will be used to show us how many children have diabetes in Oregon and where they live. This information may be used to help make decisions about allocating money and resources, and it may show us where help is needed.
