Marina shared information about the upcoming national EPHT meeting in Boston, April 7-10. Mandy reviewed the current status of Oregon EPHT and reminded DUNC members that launch of the new website and portal is scheduled for September, 2008. Mandy summarized the feedback on the wireframes document that DUNC members provided in individual meetings during February 2008. Overall feedback was positive, and many comments about potential improvements have already been incorporated into the design for the Oregon EPHT web-based query application.

Jean presented an overview of the User Acceptance Testing (UAT) process, which is scheduled to take place for Oregon EPHT between August 1<sup>st</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>, 2008. DUNC members can provide EPHT with much needed feedback and testing during this week, either at their workstations or in a central location at the Portland State Office Building. If members will be unavailable during this time, they were asked to provide us with contact information for an alternate tester from their agency. Mandy shared an update from Nita Heimann about the addition of cancer datasets to Vista PHw and the upcoming formation of a workgroup to revise guidelines for use and sharing of public health datasets.
