

Oregon Vaccine Requirements for School and Children's Facilities
Quick Summary
School Year 2009-2010

This document is a summary only. Oregon's vaccine requirements vary by the age of the child, the child's previous vaccination history and by the grade level of the child. For more information, contact your local county health department, or the DHS Immunization Program at 971-673-0300.

Children must have at least one dose of each vaccine required for their age and grade level to begin child care, Head Start, preschool or school attendance. Oregon also recognizes medical and religious exemptions. Each year, immunization records are reviewed. Children whose records show they are behind on their shots may receive an exclusion order. An exclusion order denies school or daycare attendance if needed vaccines are not received by a specific date.

Diphtheria/ Tetanus/ Pertussis	Child Care Head Start Preschool	4 doses, or age appropriate
	Grades 7-8	1 dose of Tdap at or after 10 th birthday
	Grades K-6, 9-12	5 doses, unless the 4th dose was received after age 4 years, then 4 doses
Hepatitis B	Child Care Head Start Preschool	3 doses, or age appropriate
	Grades K-6	3 doses
	Grades 7-11	3 doses, unless provider is using 2-dose formulation
Hepatitis A	Child Care Head Start Preschool	2 doses, or age appropriate
	Grades K-1	2 doses
<i>Haemophilus influenzae</i> Type B (Hib)	Child Care Head Start Preschool	Age appropriate
HPV	Not Required	

Vaccine	Age/Grade	Comments
H1N1 Influenza	Not Required	
Influenza (Flu)-- Seasonal	Not Required	
Measles*	Child Care Head Start Preschool	1 dose, on or after 1st birthday
	Grades K-12	2 doses, both after 1st birthday and at least 28 days apart
Meningococcal	Not Required	
Mumps, Rubella*	Child Care Head Start Preschool	1 dose, on or after 1st birthday
	Grades K-12	1 dose, on or after 1st birthday
Pneumococcal	Not Required	
Polio	Child Care Head Start Preschool	3 doses, or age appropriate.
	Grades K-12	4 doses, unless 3rd dose given after 4th birthday, then 3 doses
Varicella (chickenpox)	Child Care Head Start Preschool	1 dose, on or after 1st birthday
	Grades K-12	1 dose on or after 1st birthday, unless 1st dose given after 13th birthday, then 2 doses

*Most providers in Oregon give measles, mumps and rubella together in one shot called MMR. Two doses of MMR will fulfill the two-dose measles requirement.
