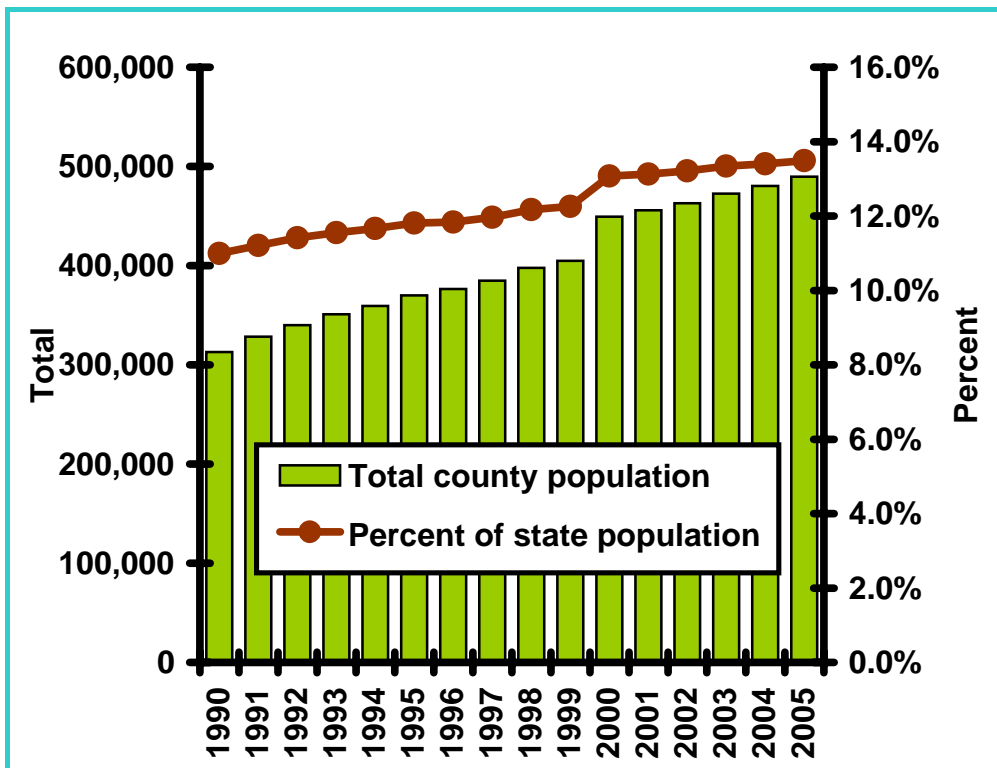


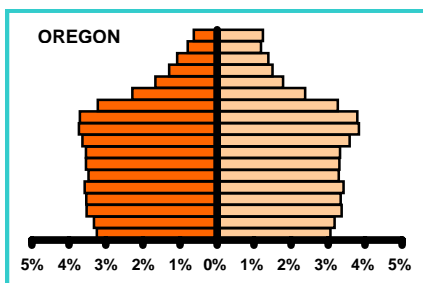

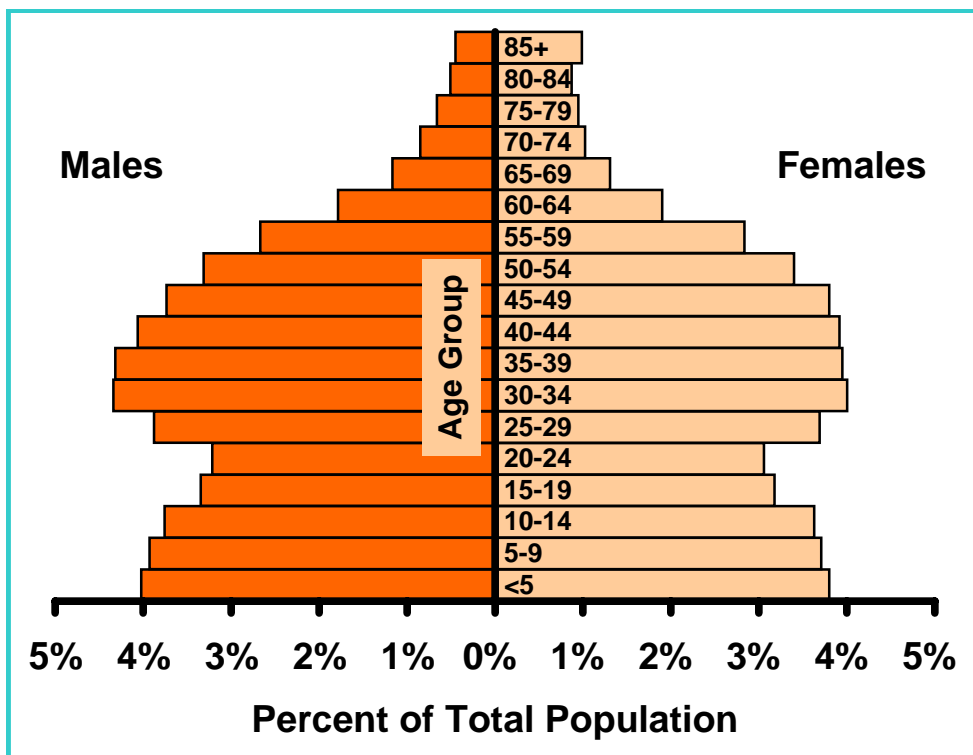
**Population Growth in

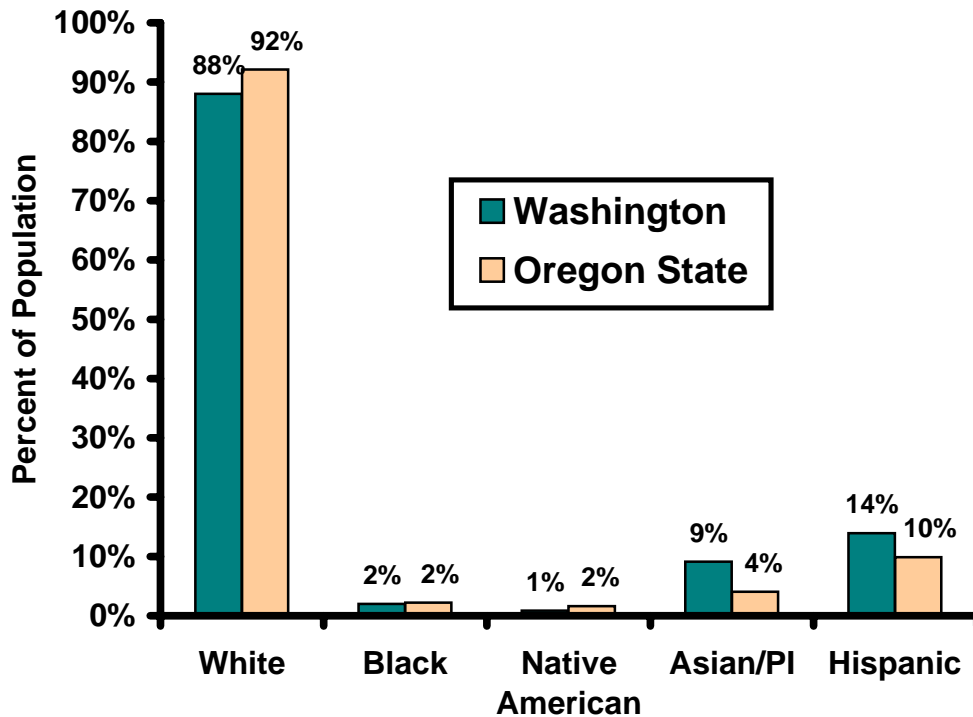
**Population Distribution by

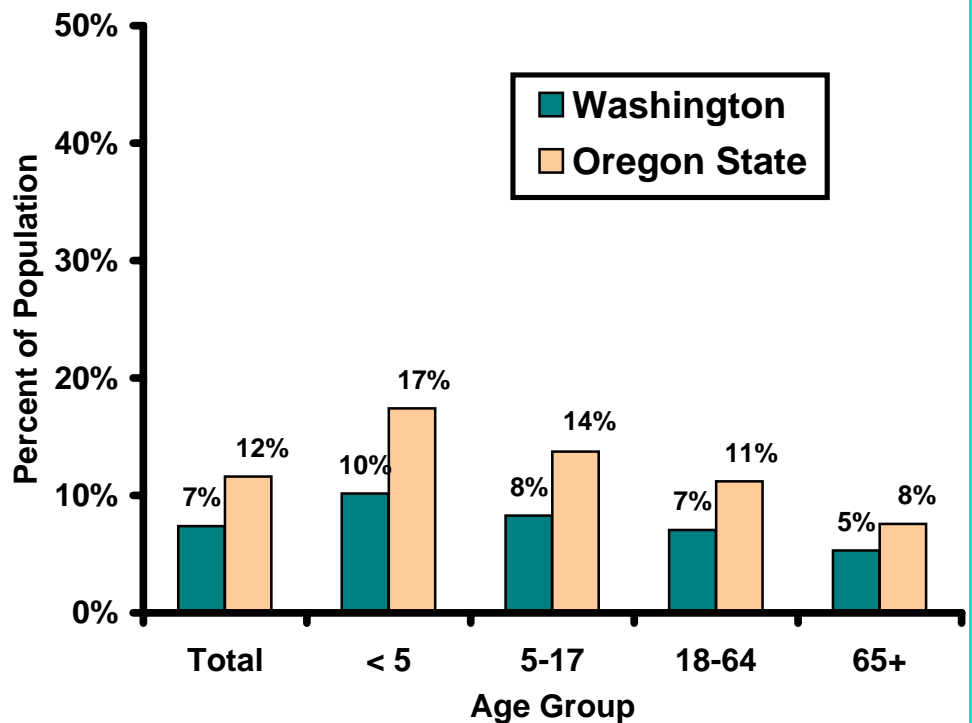

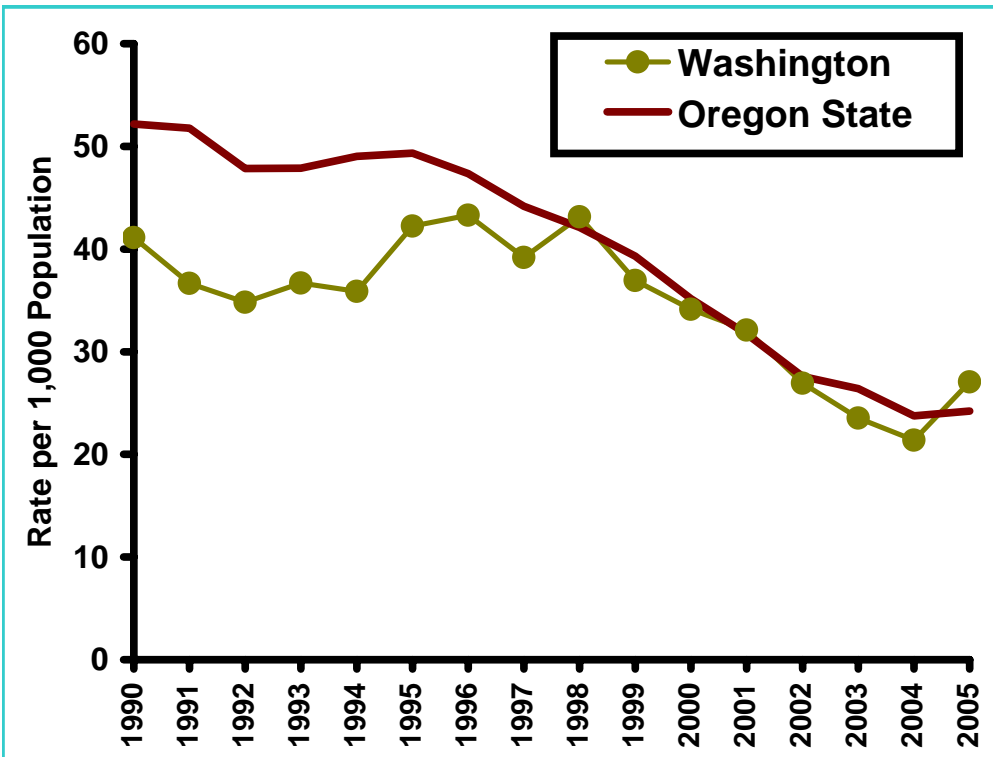

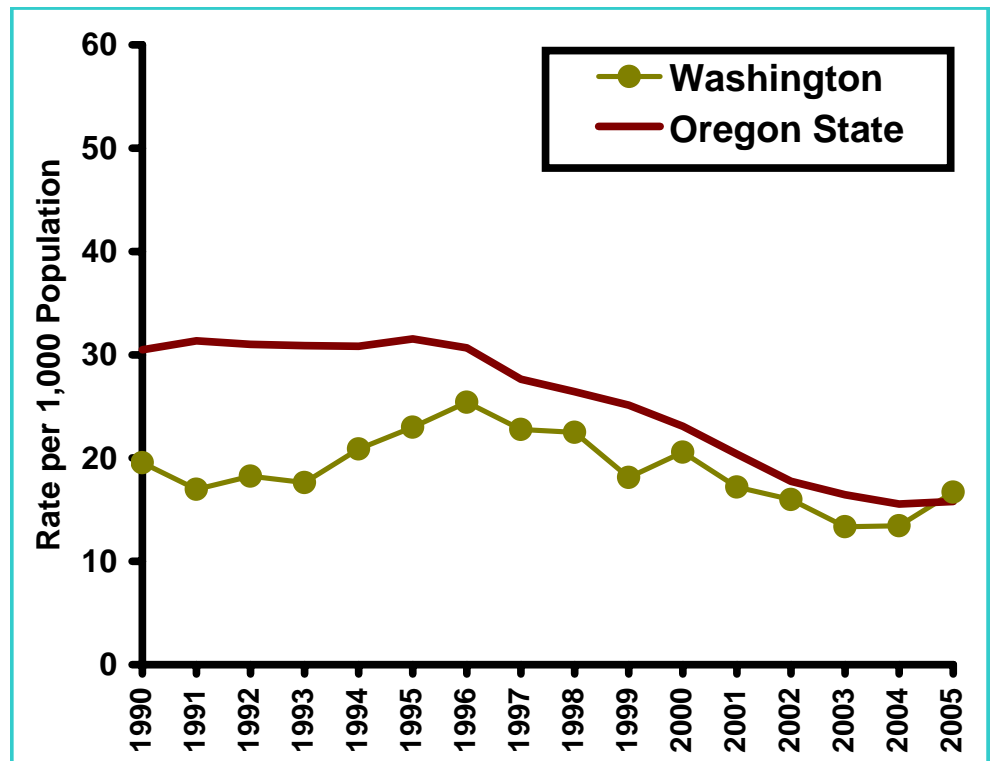

Teen (15-17) Pregnancy Rates in Oregon State and Washington County, 1990-2005

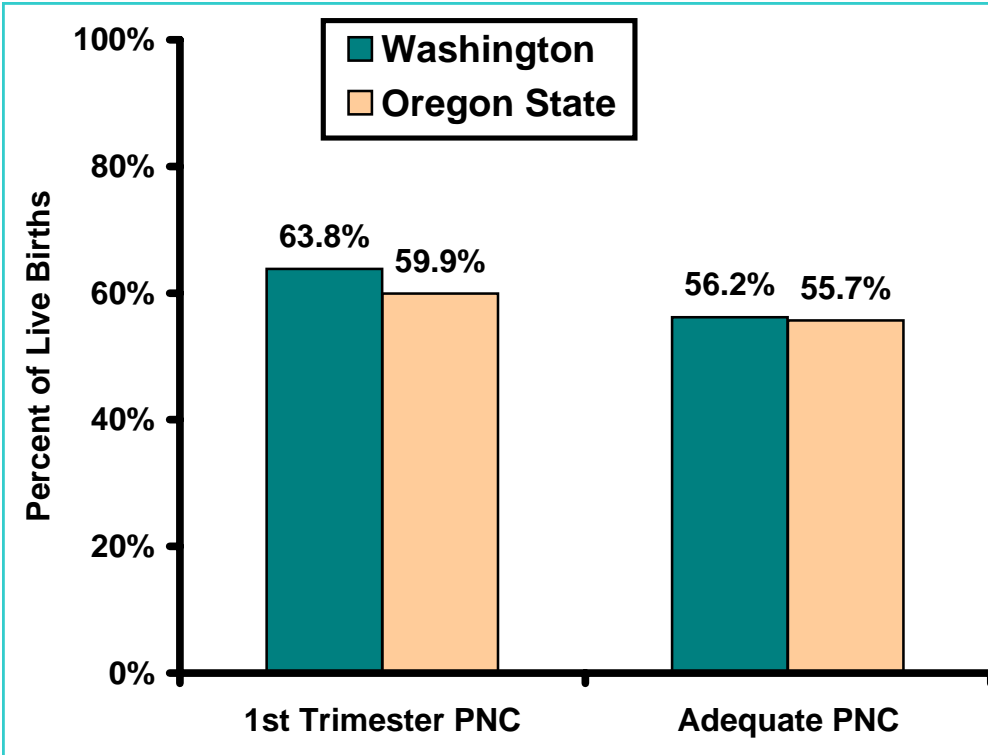

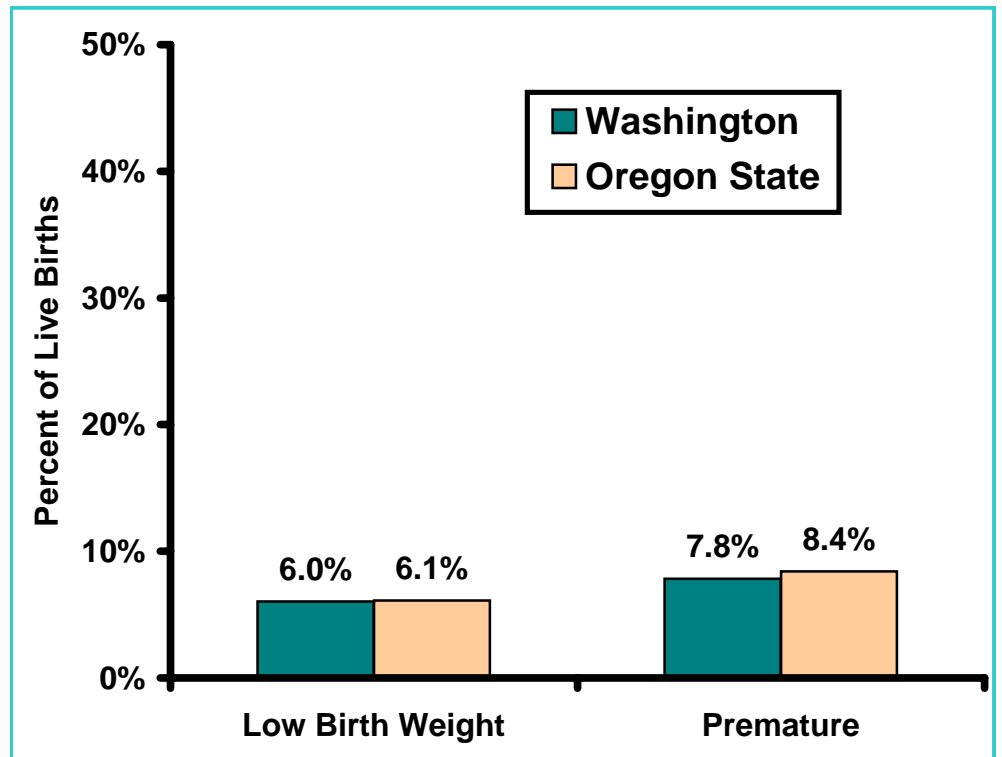
Teen Pregnancy and Birth in Washington County, 2005



Prenatal Care for Teen (15-17) Mothers in Oregon State and Washington County, 2003-2005 average

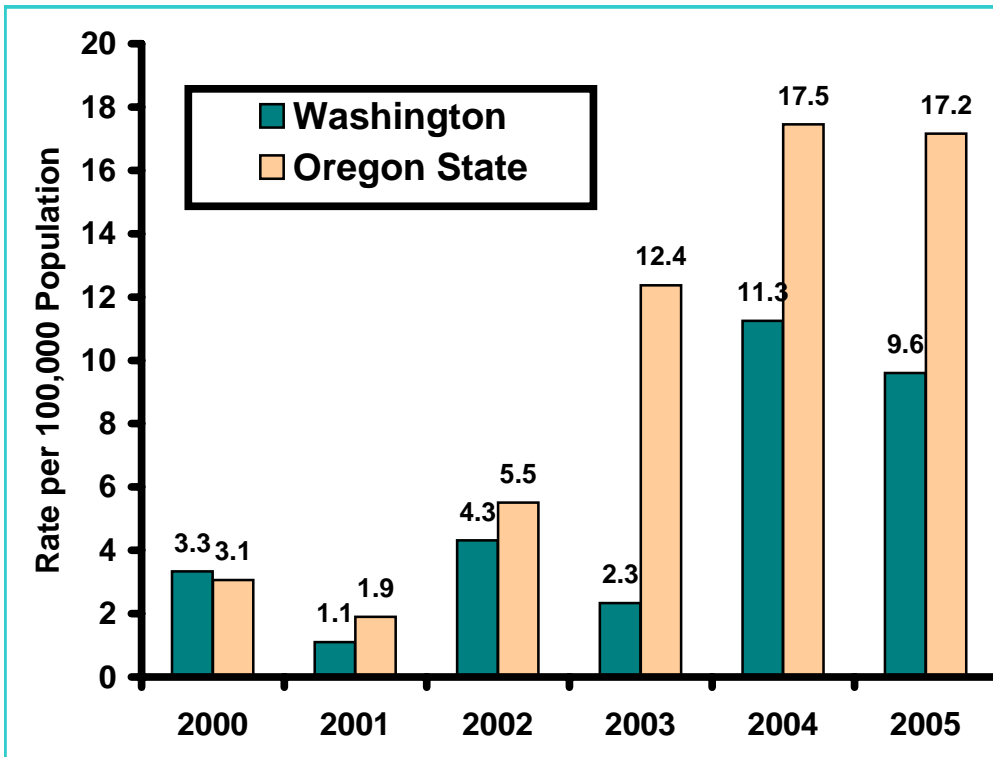

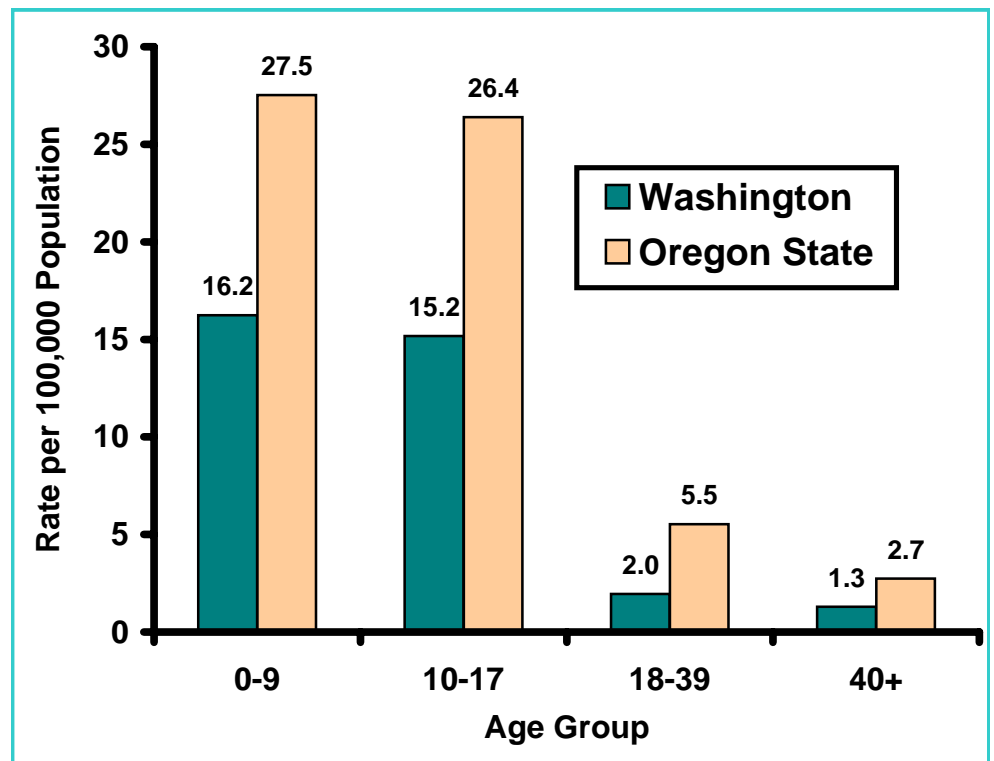
Pertussis in Washington County, 2005



Pertussis Rates in Oregon State and Washington County, 2000-2005

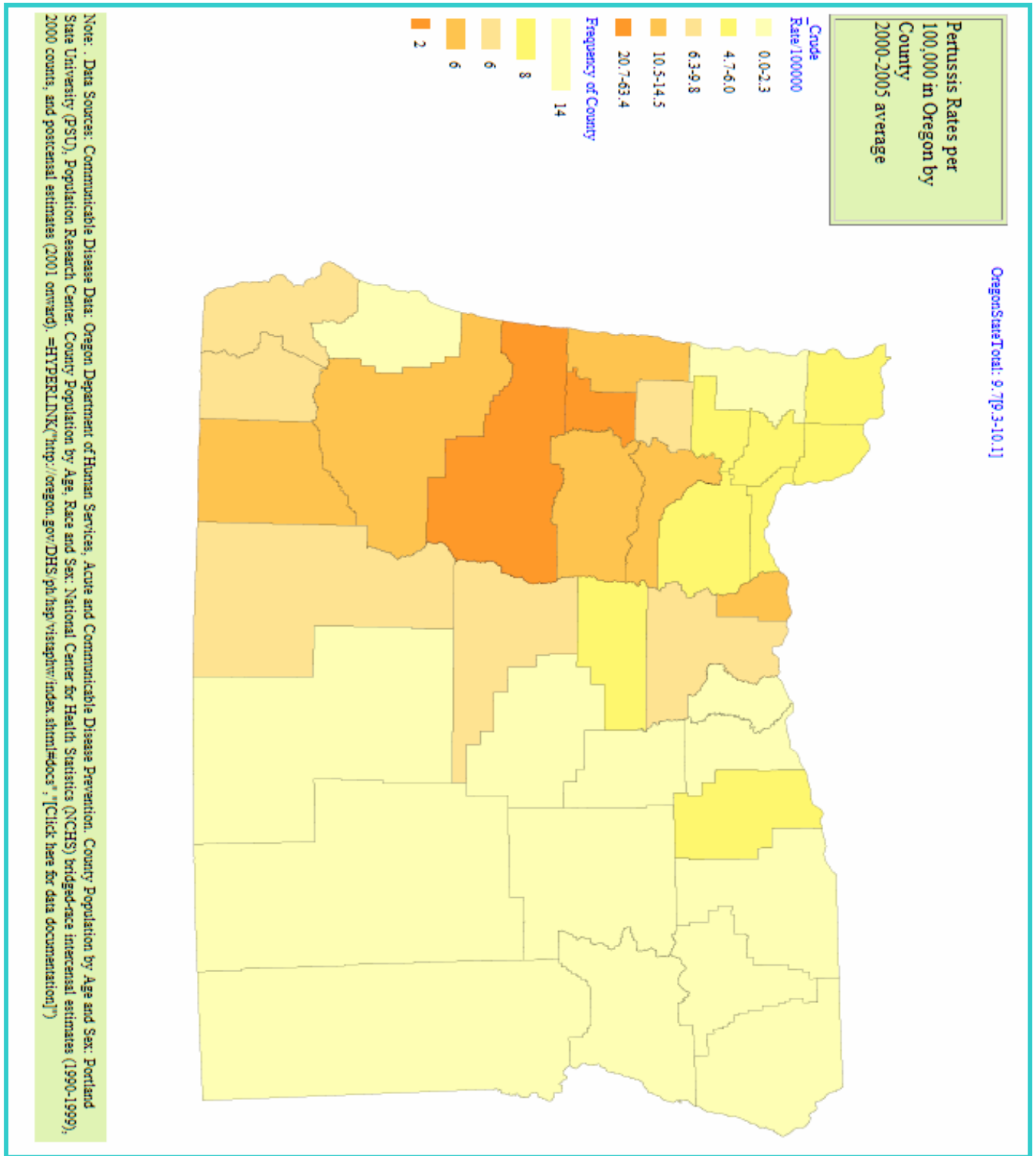

Pertussis Rates By Age Group in Oregon State and Washington County, 2000-2005 average

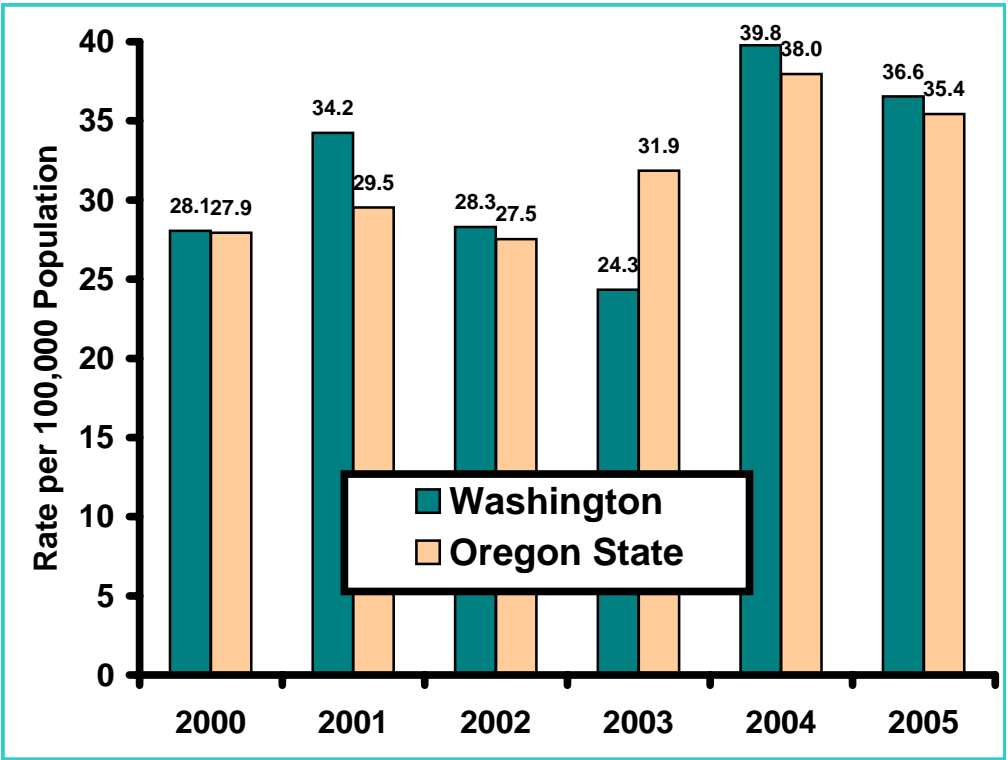

Vaccine-Preventable Disease in Washington County, 2005

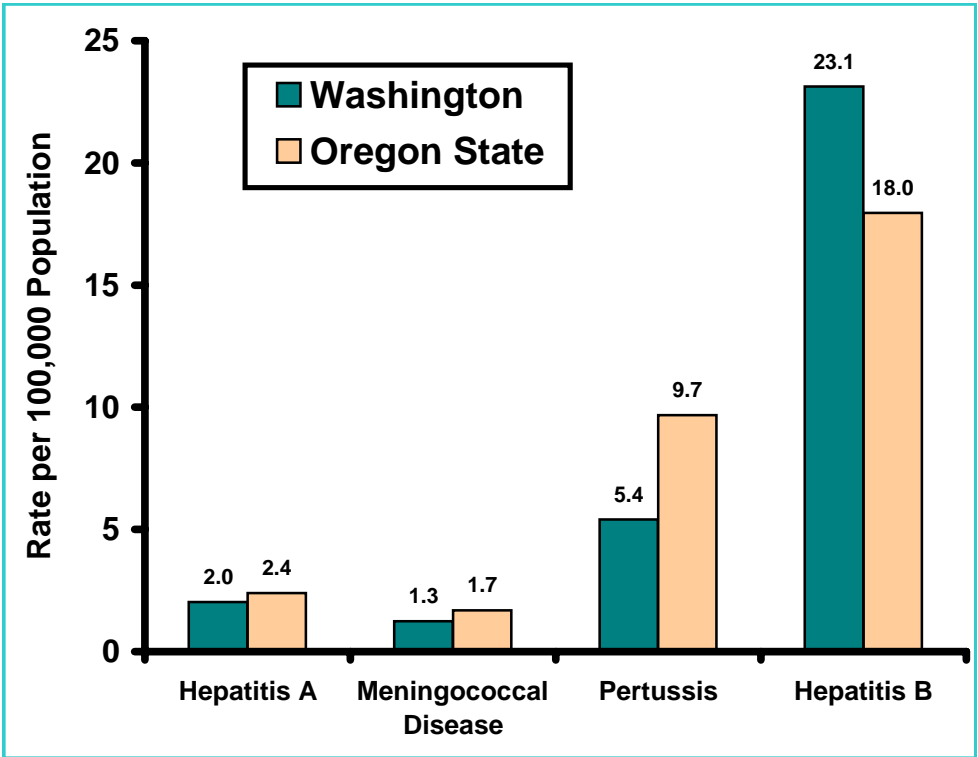


Vaccine-Preventable Disease Rates in Oregon State and Washington County, 2000-2005

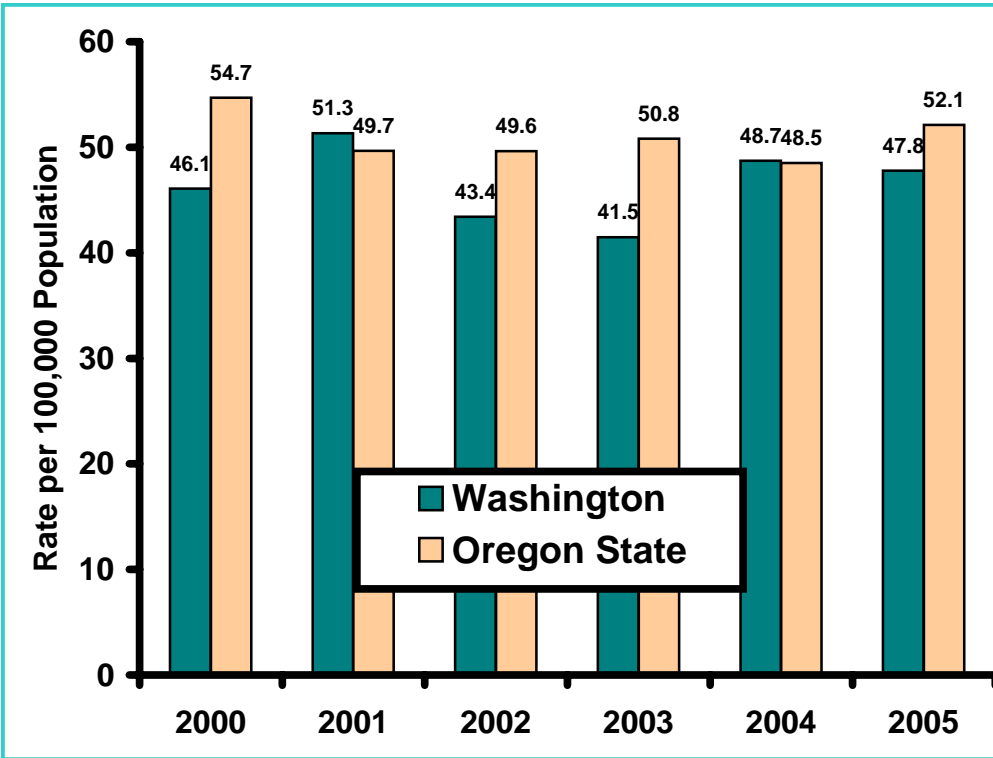

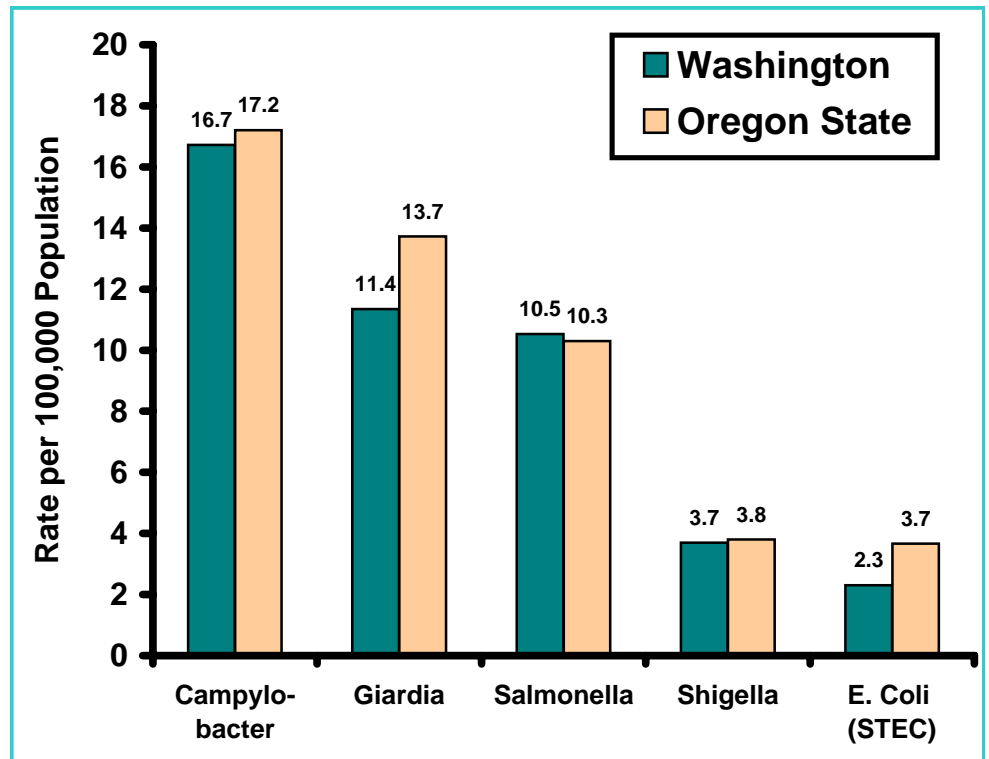

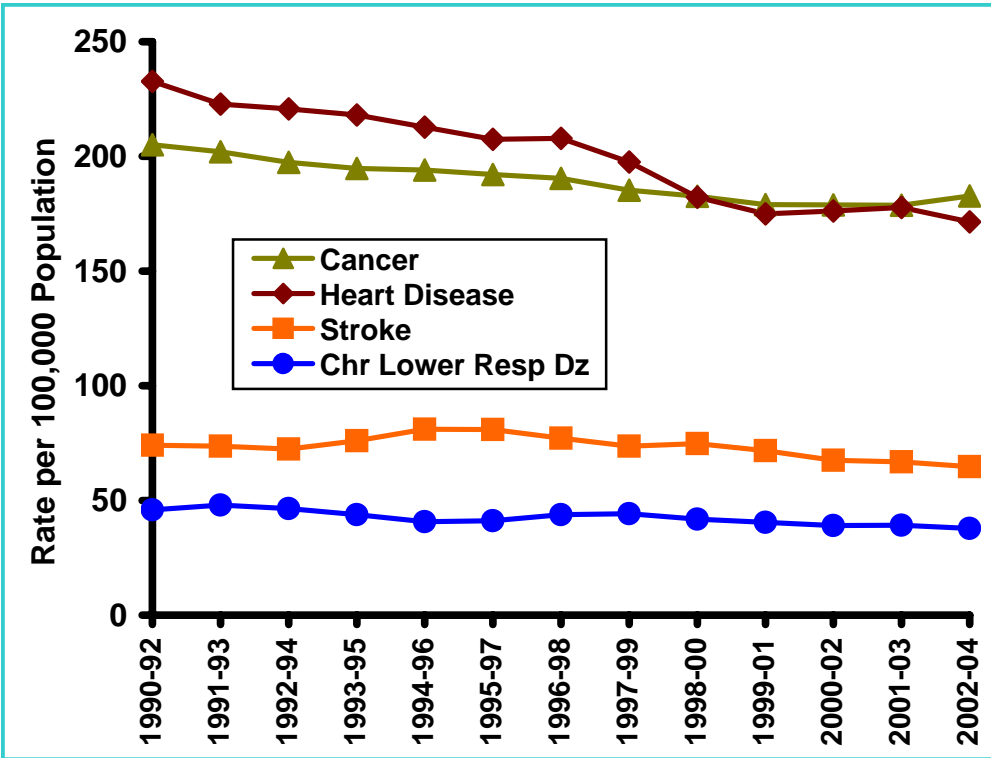

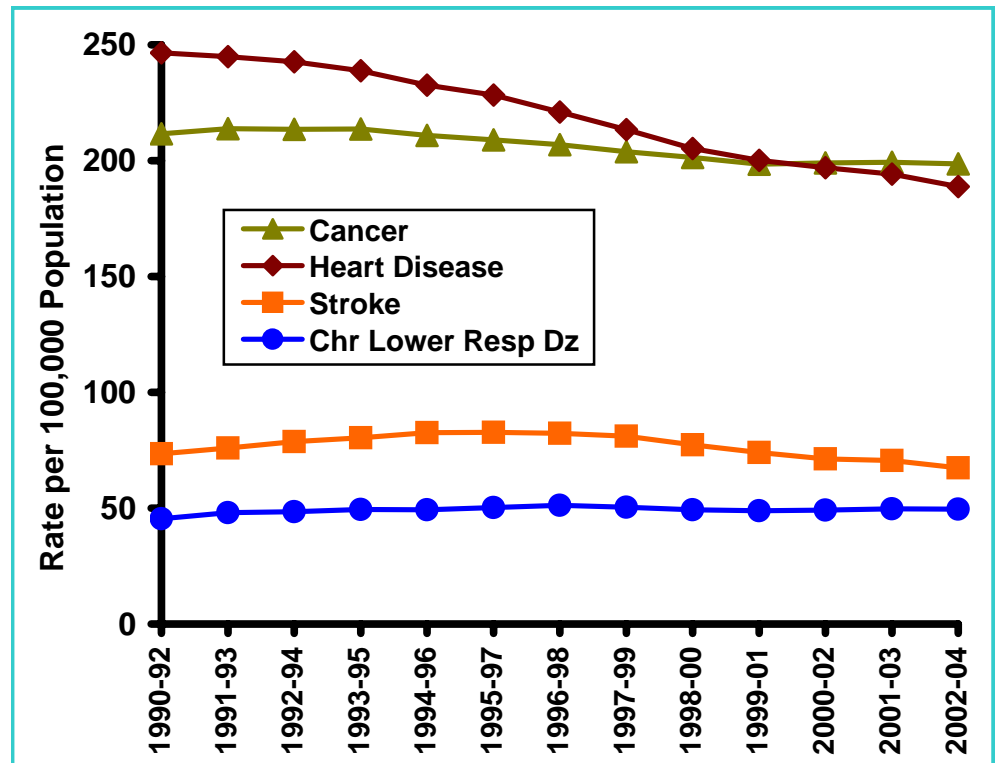
Chronic Disease Deaths in Washington County, 2004

1990-2004 rolling averages

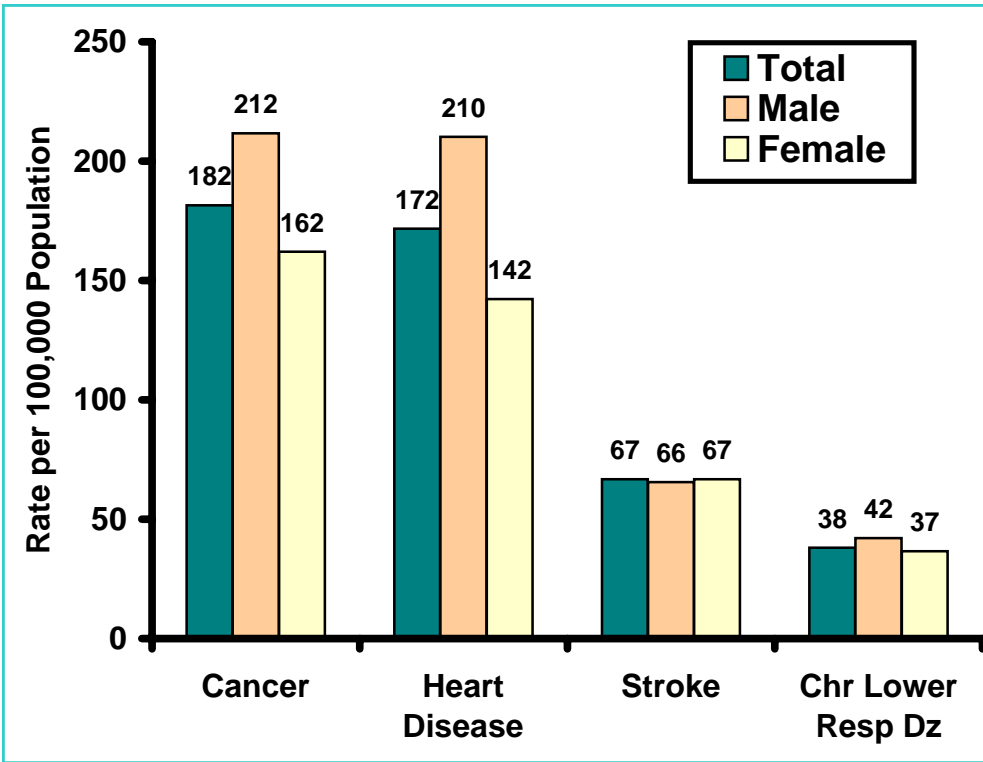

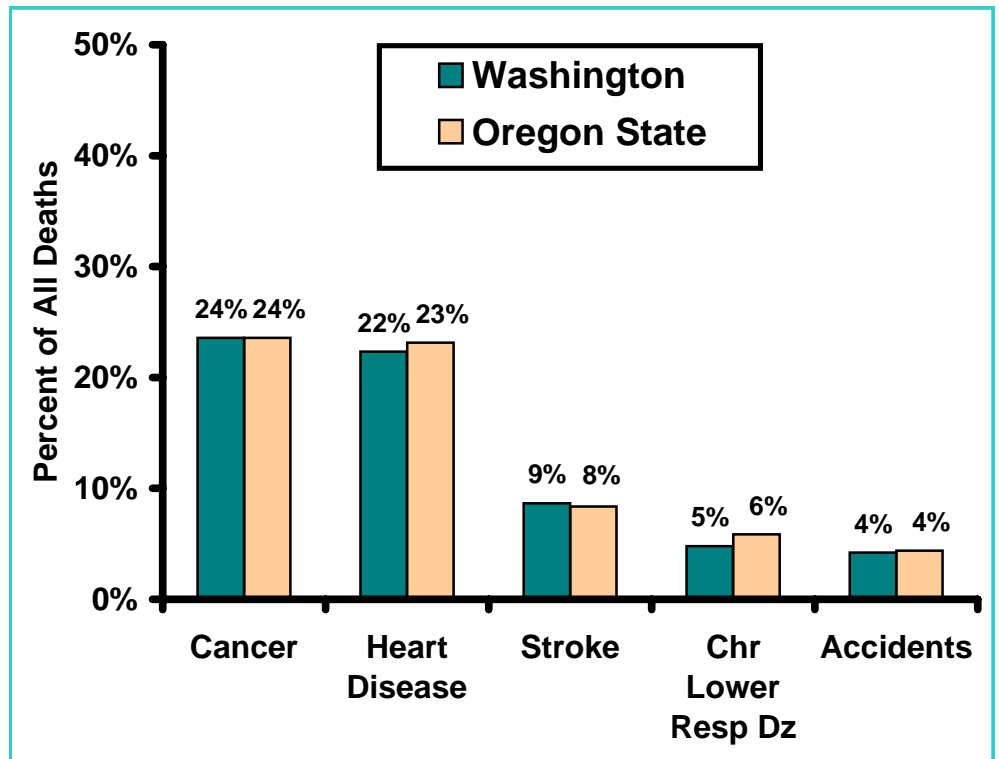
Chronic Disease Deaths in Washington County, 2004
