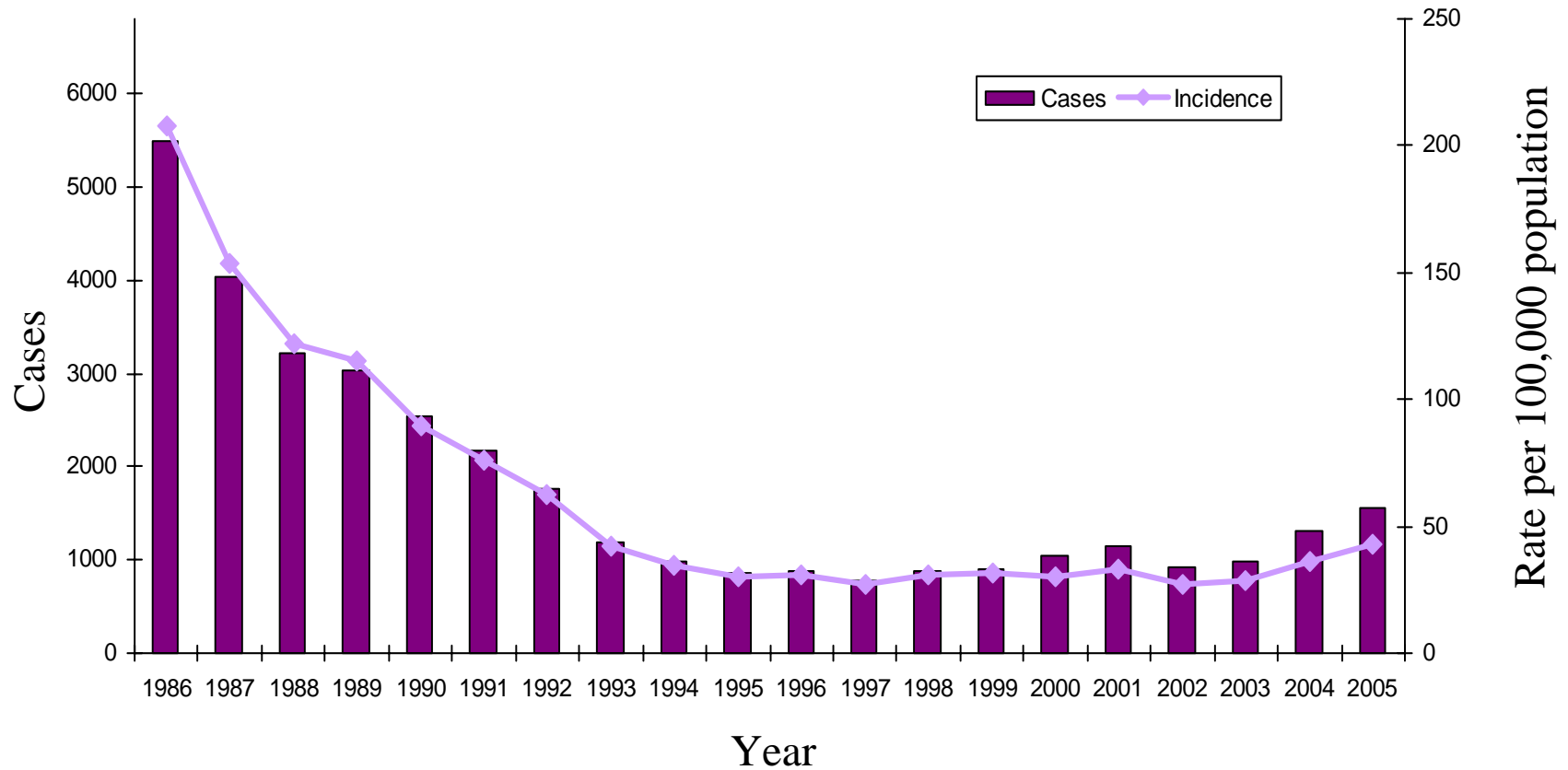
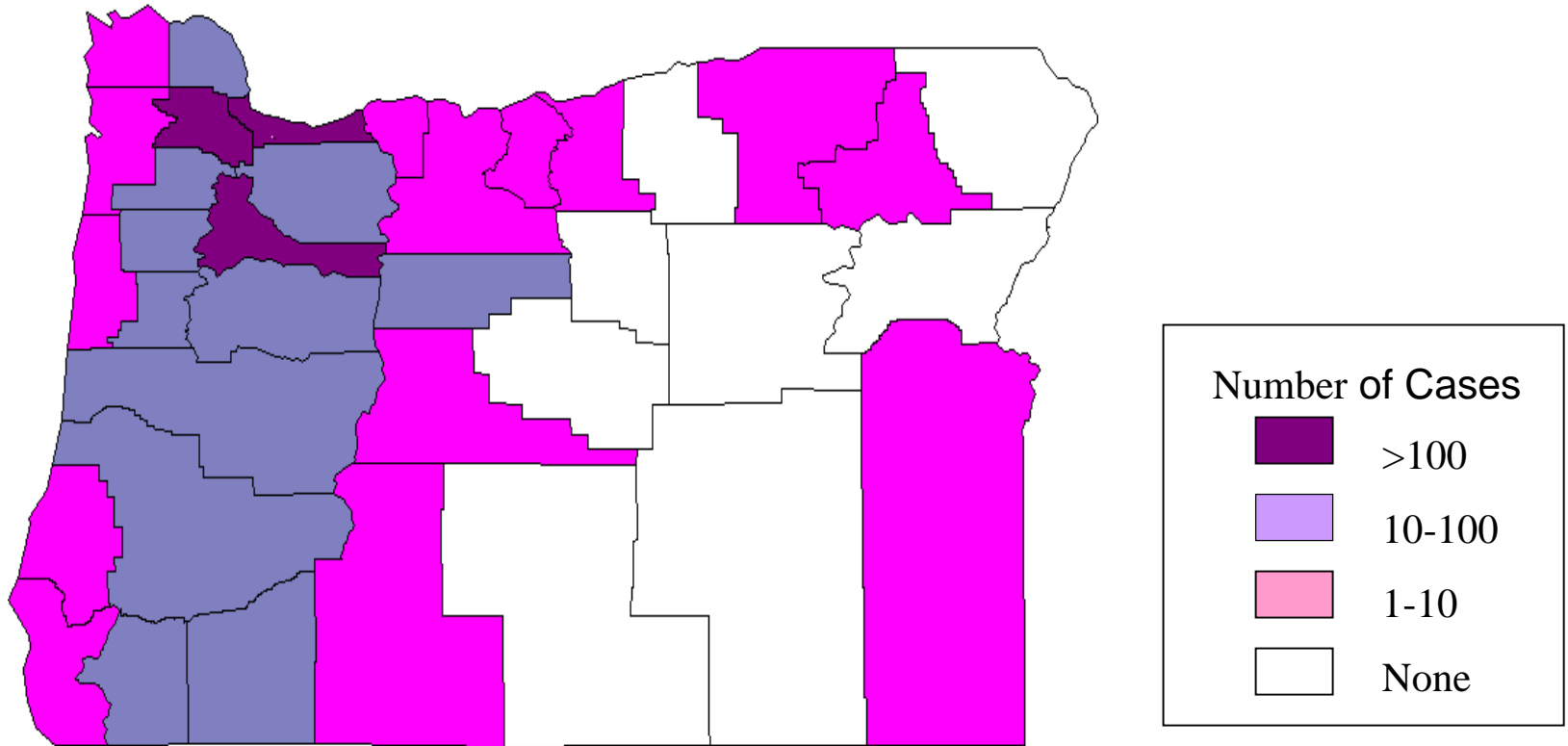

Gonorrhea Cases by County of Residence Oregon, 2005

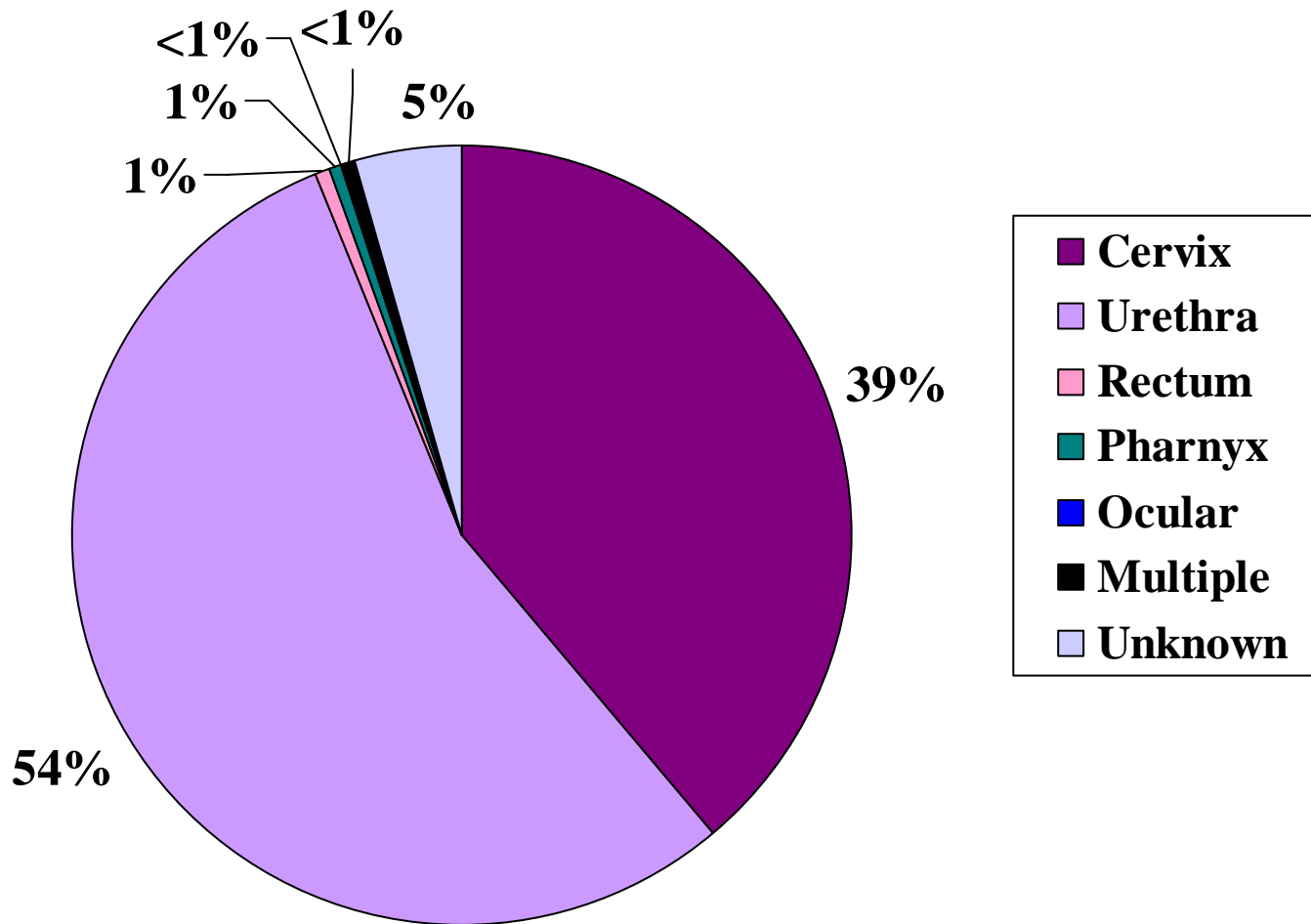

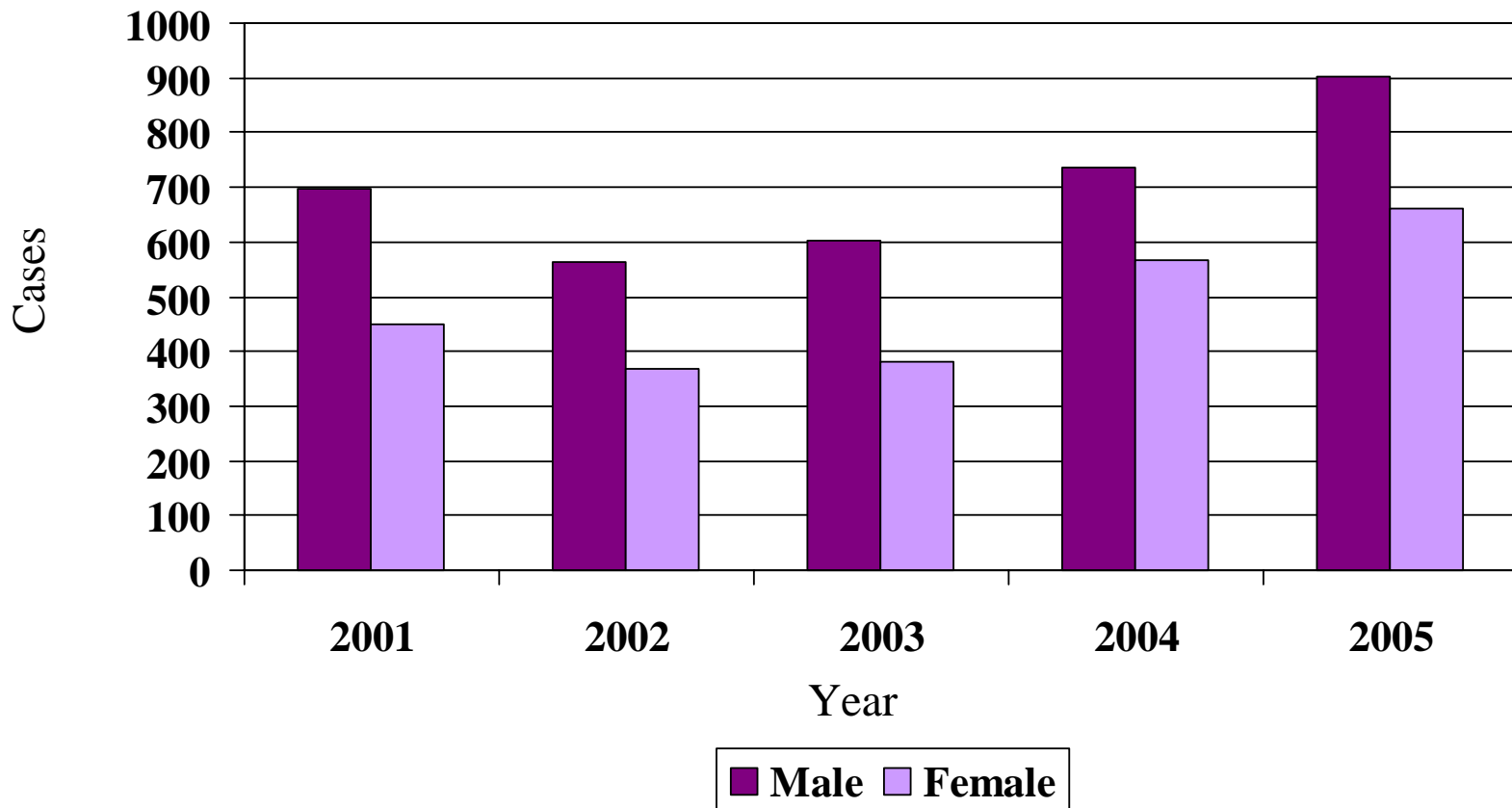

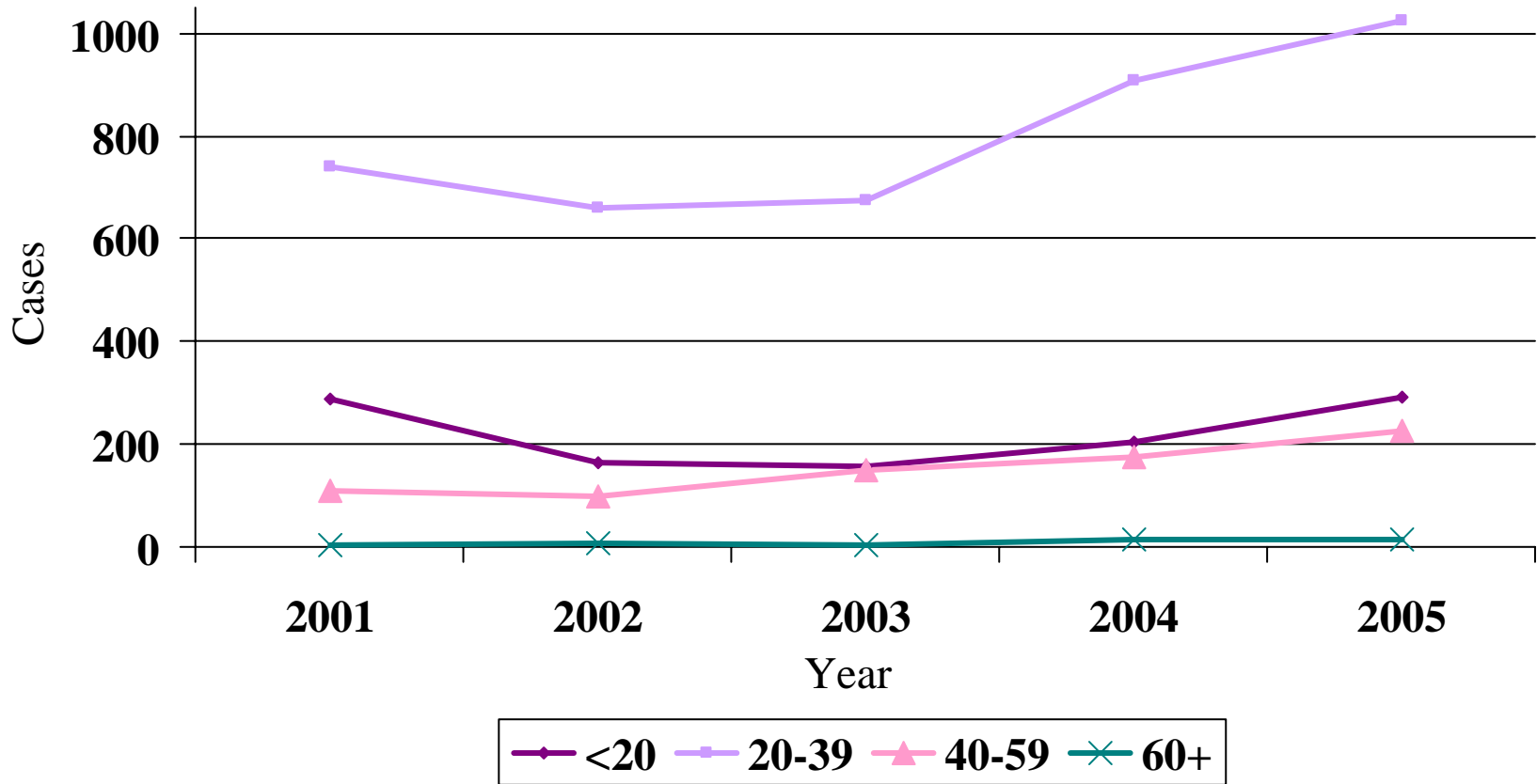
Gonorrhea Cases by Site of Diagnosis Oregon, 2005



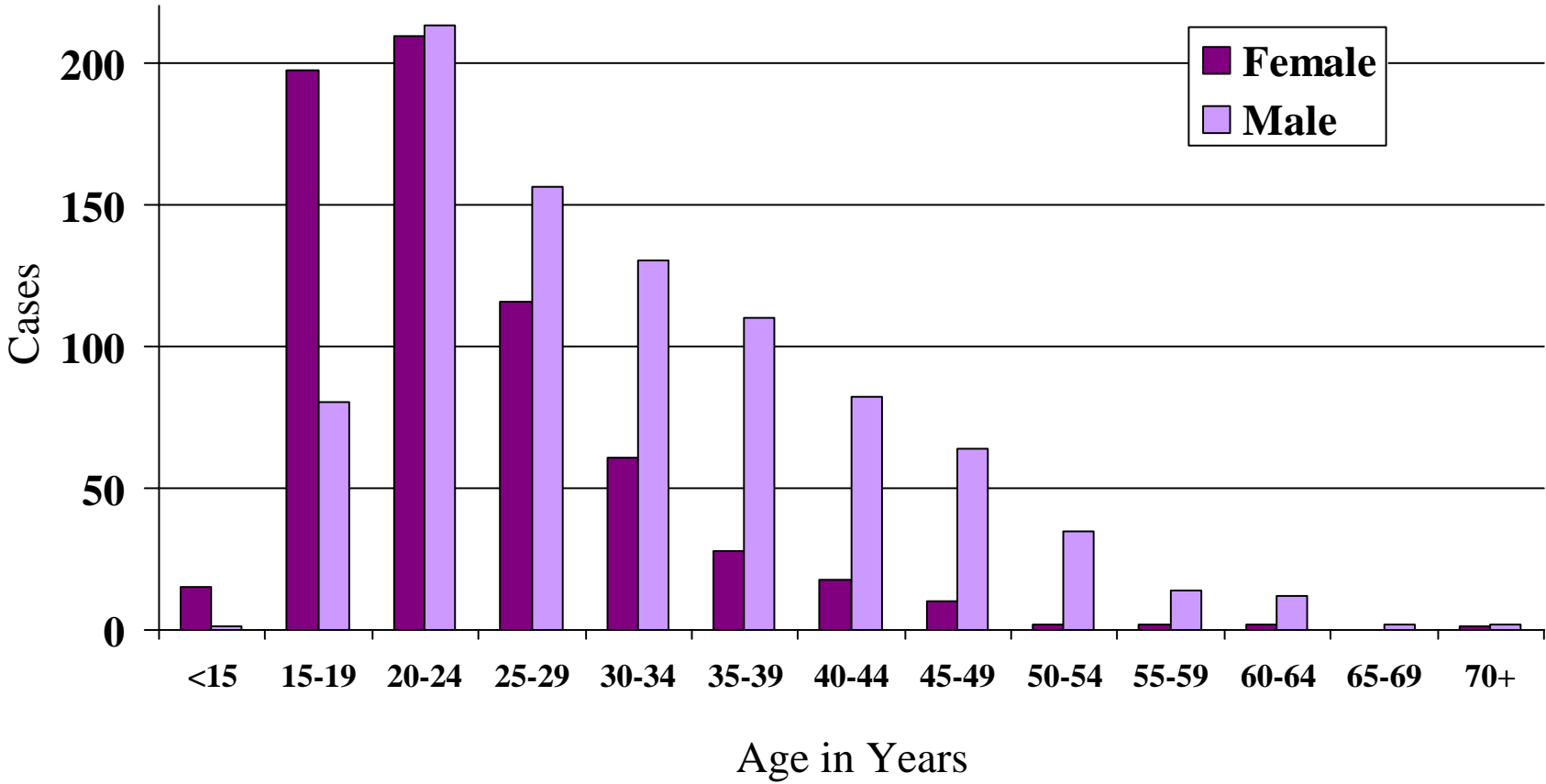
Gonorrhea Cases by Gender Oregon, 2001-2005



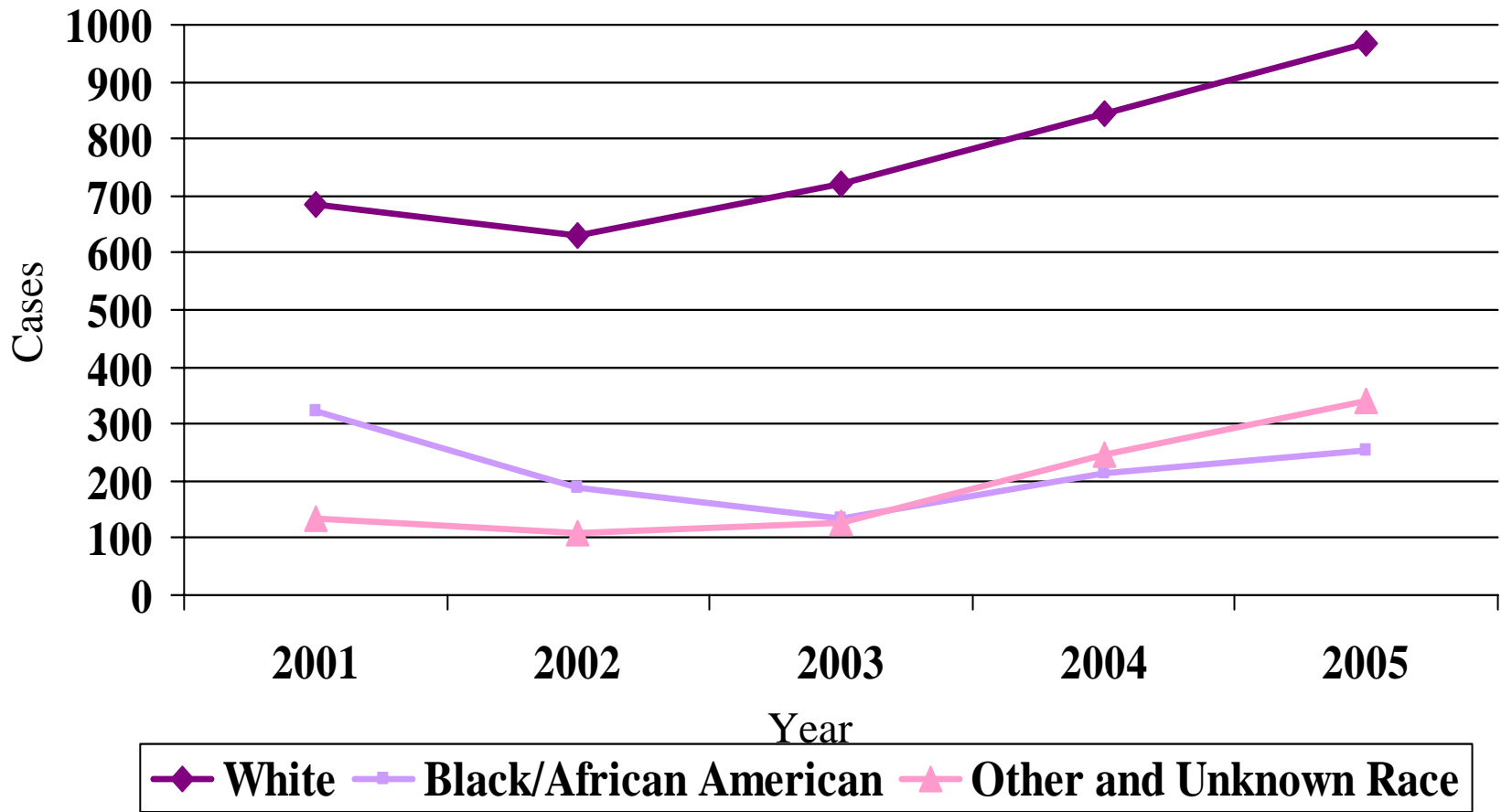
Gonorrhea Cases by Age Group Oregon, 2001-2005



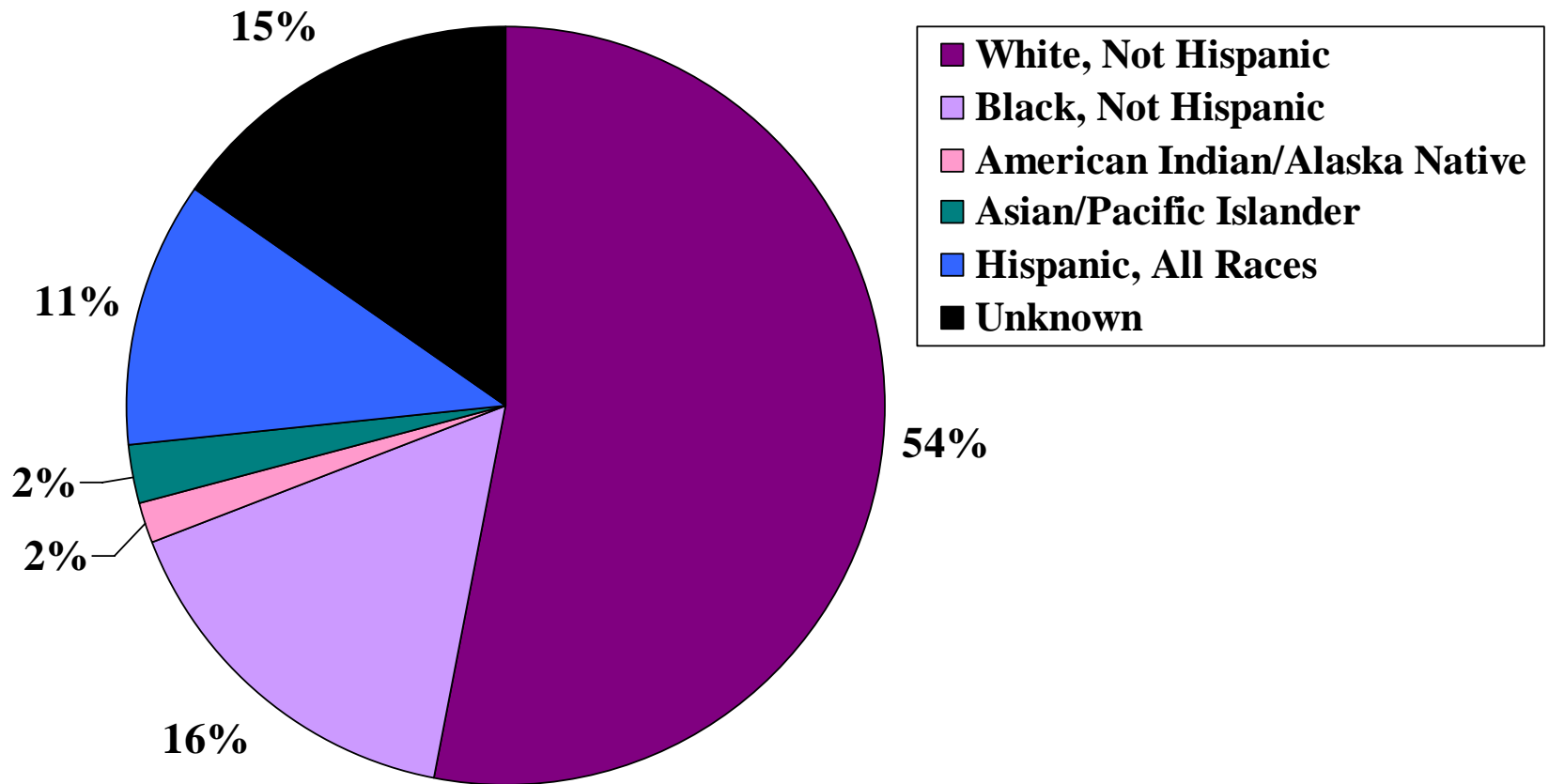
Gonorrhea Cases by Gender and Age Oregon, 2005



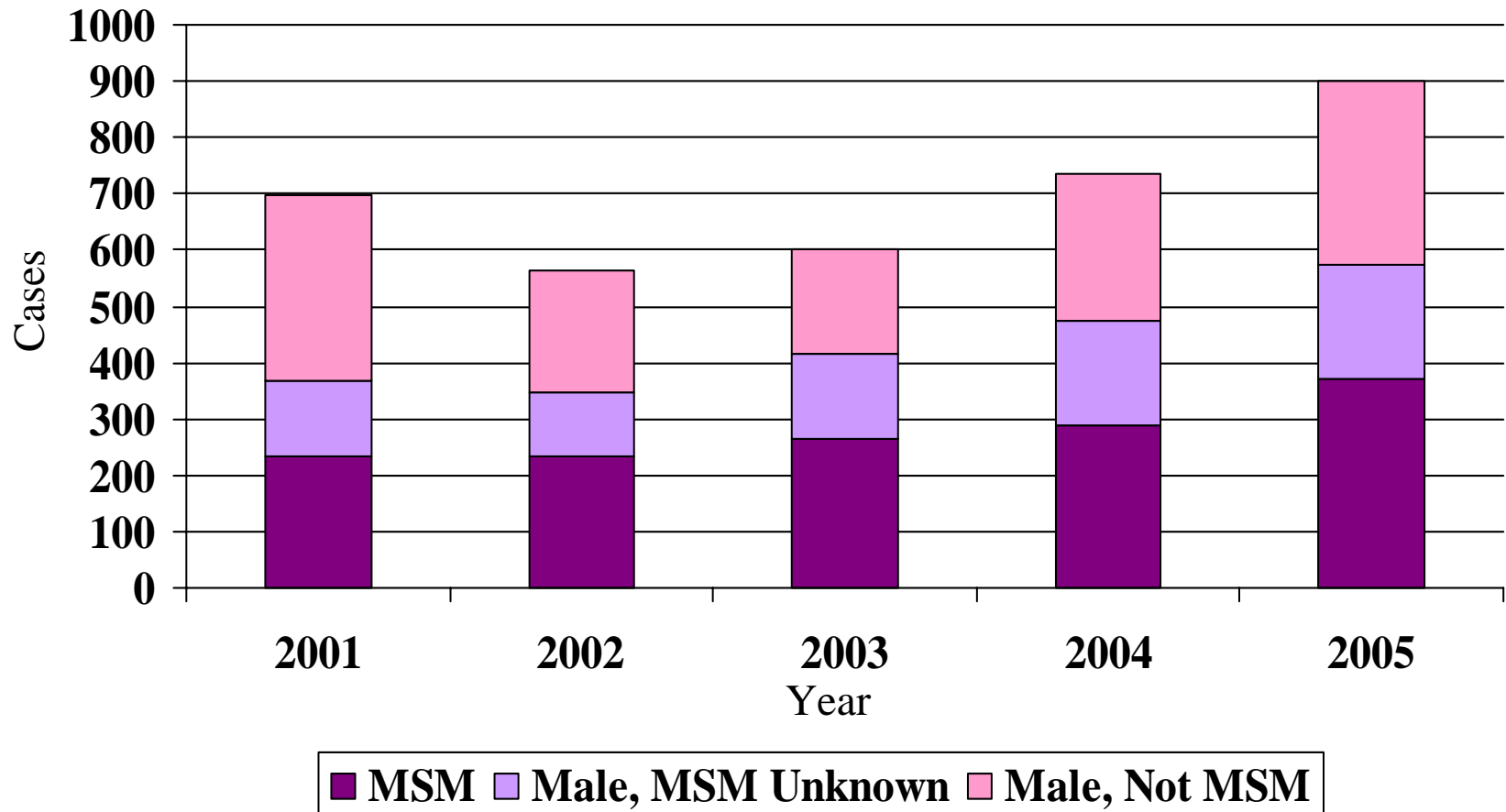
Gonorrhea Cases by Race Oregon 2001-2005



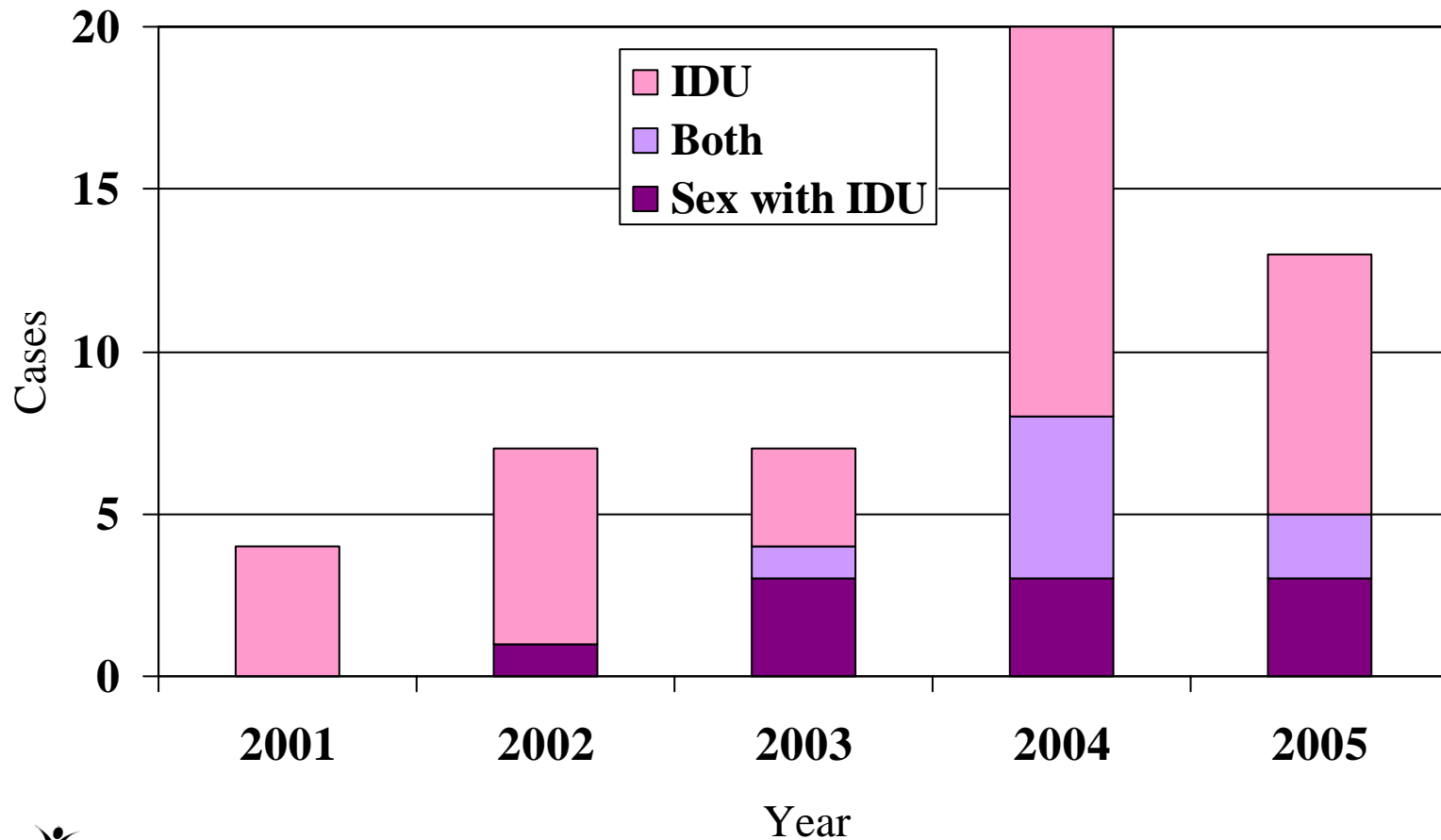
Gonorrhea Cases by Race & Ethnicity Oregon, 2005



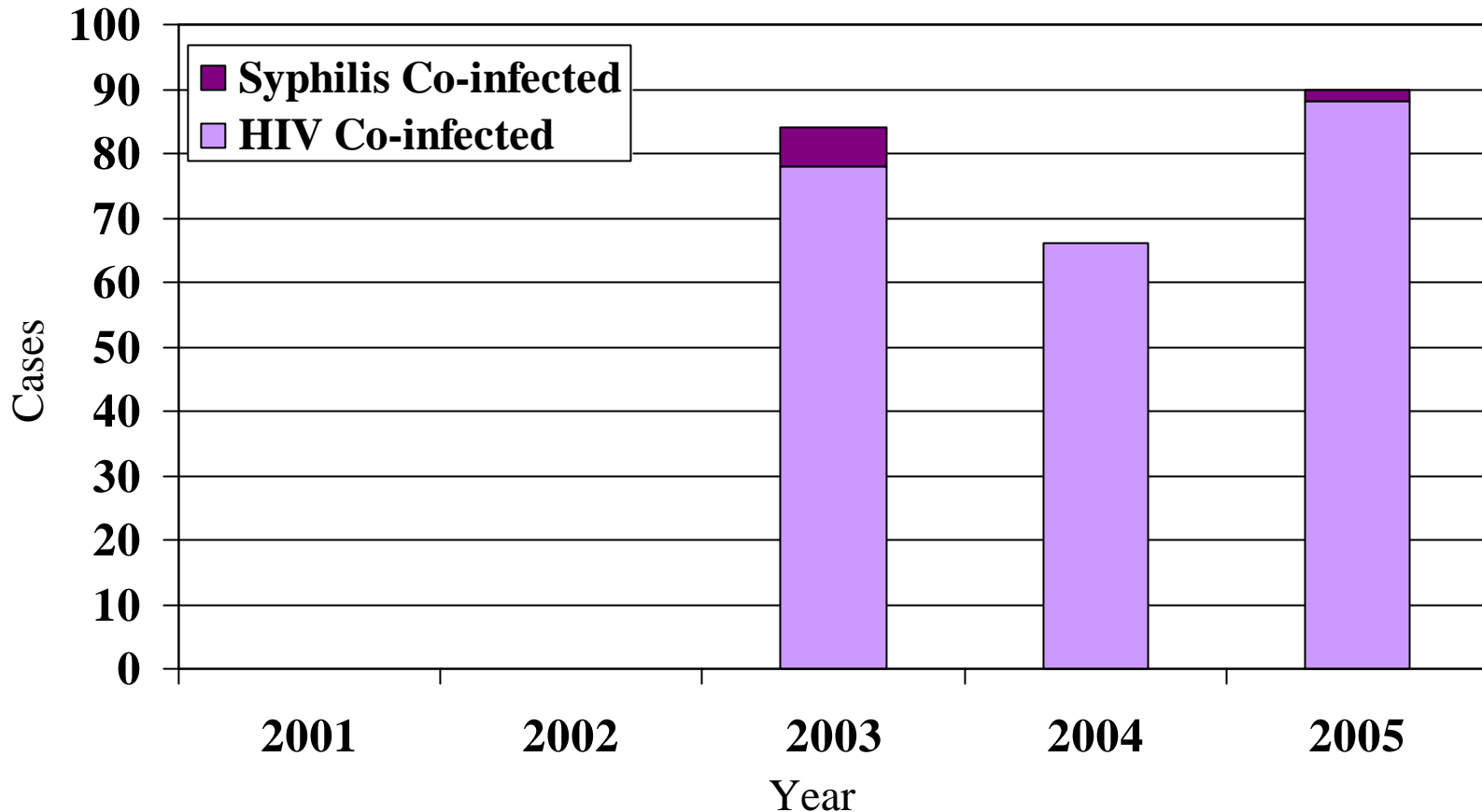
Gonorrhea Cases among Men by MSM Status Oregon 2001-2005
