

**This page contains a brief explanation of some of the common entries found on driving records:**

**Current License & Permit Classifications:**

**Commercial Types:** **Class A:** May drive any vehicle or combination of vehicles with the proper endorsement. **Class B:** May drive any single vehicle with the proper endorsements. May tow a trailer up to 10,000 pounds GVWR (Gross Vehicle Weight Rating). If the trailer has a loaded weight of more than 10,000 pounds, the gross weight of the combination (Towing vehicle and trailer) must be less than 26,000 pounds. **Class C:** May drive any single vehicle, which does not weigh more than 26,000 pounds with the proper endorsements. **PCDL:** Commercial instruction permit.

**Non-Commercial:** **Class C:** Any single vehicle weighing less than 26,000 lbs and designed to carry 15 or fewer passengers. May tow another vehicle with a loaded weight of less than 10,000 lbs. Combined weight cannot exceed 26,000. May operate moped. **Restricted Class C:** Operate moped only. **PC:** Non commercial instruction permit. **PM:** Motorcycle instruction permit. **I:** Identification Card only - No valid driving privileges.

**Current Endorsements:** **M** = Motorcycle endorsement for any motorcycle. **S** = School Bus. **T** = Doubles/Triples. **X** = Combination hazardous materials/tank. **Y** = Farm Endorsement (Class A). **Z** = Farm Endorsement (Class B). **P** = Passenger (vehicles designed to carry more than 15 people). **H** = Hazardous materials. **N** = Tanks (Does not include portable tanks with a capacity of less than 1,000 gallons).

**Current Restrictions:** **B** = Corrective lenses. **D** = Anatomical donor. **E** = Automatic transmission. **F** = Outside mirror. **G** = Daylight driving only. **J** = Route restricted. **K** = CDL Intrastate. **L** = Vehicle without air brakes. **M** = No class A passenger vehicles. **N** = No class A or B passenger vehicles. **R** = Hand controls. **S** = Turn signals. **U** = Prosthetic aid. **V** = Emancipated minor. **1** School bus weight on DOE certificate. **2** = Emergency permit. **3** = Student permit. **4** = Golf cart permit. **5** = Moped.

**DRIVING RECORD ENTRIES**

**Accidents:** The following explains how accident entries are displayed on the driving record.

(a) ACC (b) 08/23/90 (c) 1 \* (d) 34-1755 (e) STP (f) EMPLOY (g) CMV (h) HAZ

(a) Indicates a reportable accident. (b) Date of accident. (c) Type of accident: 1 = One other vehicle. 2 = Two more other vehicles. 3 = Pedestrian. 4 = Train. 6 = Bicycle. 8 = Animal. 9 = Streetcar. X = Fixed object. R = Non-collision. P = Police report filed. \* = Police report filed, fatal accident. (d) DMV internal reference number. (e) STP means vehicle was stopped at time of the accident. (f) Indicates accident was employment related. (g) CMV= commercial motor vehicle indicator. (h) HAZ = CMV was carrying hazardous materials.

**Convictions:** The following explains how convictions are displayed on the driving record.

(a) Conviction entered to driving record. (b) Date citation was issued. (c) Date driver was convicted by court. (d) Name of the offense. A list of the most common offenses is shown in the table below. (e) Type of court: J = Justice; D = District; C = Circuit; M = Municipal; X = Juvenile. (f) Five letter abbreviations following the court type indicates court name. Two letter abbreviations indicate the conviction occurred in another state. (g) DMV Internal number. (h) 'GD' Indicates that conviction was by default; defendant failed to show up in court. (i) "EMPLOY" means conviction was employment related. (j) Class and type of offense. Types of offenses are: M = Misdemeanor; F = Felony; I = Infraction; V = Violation. Class codes will be A, B, C, D or blank. (k) If conviction was speed-related, actual speed will be shown followed by posted/designated speed. (l) CMV = commercial motor vehicle indicator. (m) HAZ = CMV was carrying hazardous materials.

**Suspensions:** The following explains how suspensions appear on a driving record.

(a) SUSP (b) 03/10/92 (c) 03/09/93 (d) CO/DUII (e) D - MARON (f) PRU PENDING (g) ARREST 12/31/91  
(h) STATUS: PAR 06/10/92 (i) REIN BUS 06/10/92 (j) PARTIAL REINSTATED

(a) Indicates suspension entered on driving record. (b) Date suspension took effect. (c) If suspension has an ending date, it displays here. If PERM or LIFE displays it means suspension is a lifetime suspension. If field shows INDEF or 00/00/00, action is in effect until requirements for reinstatement are met. (d) Reason for the suspension. (See suspension types below.) (e) See (e) under Conviction section for explanation of court type and location. (f) PRU PENDING means driver is required to file proof of financial responsibility (SR22) before reinstating driving privilege. PRU DATE followed by actual date means driver is required to file proof of financial responsibility until that date, otherwise this field will be blank. (g) Date of arrest if suspension is related to a conviction. DMV's accident reference number if the suspension is related to an accident, otherwise this field will be blank. (h) Status of the suspension. Date will be date this action took place. Actions that may appear in this field are:

<b>APRD</b>	DMV was notified driver appeared for tests, interview or in court.	<b>CMPLT</b>	Driver completed alcohol treatment program.
<b>BUS</b>	Driving privileges partially reinstated. Hardship/Probationary permit issued.	<b>CPLY</b>	DMV was notified that driver complied with the requirements of the court.
<b>RCV</b>	DMV received the accident report from the driver.	<b>RND</b>	Judgment was handed down by the court.
<b>PAR</b>	Driving privileges partially reinstated. Hardship/Probationary permit issued.	<b>SAT</b>	Judgment was satisfied.

(i) Reinstatement information appears in this field. Date will be the date the action took place.

<b>REIN FULL</b>	Driving Privilege was fully reinstated.
<b>REIN</b>	If zeros are displayed after the word REIN it means the action has not been reinstated.
<b>REIN BUS</b>	Driving privileges partially reinstated by issuance of Hardship/Probationary permit.

(j) **STILL SUSPENDED, STILL REVOKED OR STILL CANCELED** displays if action was not reinstated by date record was produced. Otherwise one of the following will display:

<b>ELIG FOR REIN</b>	Reinstatement requirements have been met, but reinstatement fee has not been paid, or another action is in effect.
<b>PENDING ORDER</b>	Suspension/revocation/cancellation was not in effect on date the record was produced.
<b>PARTIALLY REINSTATED</b>	Driving privilege was partially reinstated as of the date the driving record was produced.
<b>FULLY REINSTATED</b>	Driving privileges were fully reinstated as of the date shown.
<b>CURRENTLY REVOKED</b>	Revocation was partially reinstated but is now in full effect.
<b>CURRENTLY SUSPENDED</b>	Suspension was partially reinstated but is now in full effect.
<b>CURRENTLY CANCELED</b>	Cancellation was partially reinstated but is now in full effect.
<b>NO DL STATUS</b>	No driver license status. Action had no effect on driving privilege status.
<b>STATUS UNKNOWN</b>	Program was unable to determine status of action.

**Suspension Types:**

Suspensions segments that show a **CO** or **C/** indicate that the suspension was court ordered. **CMV** in the abbreviation indicates offense occurred while operating a commercial motor vehicle. **HAZ** indicate it was commercial motor vehicle carrying hazardous materials. Some common suspension codes are:

**Duplicate Entries:** The following is a brief explanation of duplicate and sticker entries on the driving record.

(a) DMV issued a duplicate. (b) Date of issue. (c) No entry means duplicate driver license or permit was issued. Otherwise, it will display:

<b>EXT/STKR</b>	Last license was renewed by mail. An address change sticker was issued on this date.	<b>STICKER</b>	Change of address sticker was issued for a license or permit.
<b>ID/STICKER</b>	Change of address sticker was issued for an ID Card.	<b>PRK PERMIT</b>	A duplicate disabled parking placard was issued.
<b>ID</b>	Duplicate Identification card was issued	<b>MCIP</b>	A duplicate motorcycle instruction permit was issued.
