Bridge replacement done, highway reopen

Highway 38 reopened at 9 p.m. Sunday between Elkton and Drain — nine hours ahead of schedule. Workers finished replacing the bridge at the east end of the Elk Creek Tunnel.

The Oregon Department of Transportation said warning signs will alert drivers that Highway 38 will be open ahead of schedule. The highway originally was planned to reopen today at 6 a.m.
