

GO OREGON! 2009
Oregon Department of Transportation Projects

The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) welcomes contractors to participate in contracting opportunities associated with the Go Oregon! stimulus package – one of several economic revitalization stimulus packages. Many of the projects are short duration (2-4 days) and are replacement or repair of facility infrastructure such as roofs, electric garage / bay doors, windows, and other projects that connect with sustainability goals for the building or structure. To facilitate the rapid deployment of projects and support the agency objective of providing local opportunity to small, disadvantaged, women and minority-owned businesses, ODOT will be soliciting bids for projects through two methods.

CONTRACTOR BIDDING INFORMATION

ODOT is continually seeking firms who are interested in doing business with ODOT to build a foundation of capable sub- and prime contractors for future small and large projects. Many projects being offered through the Go Oregon! stimulus package require attendance of a mandatory pre-bid conference at the project geographic location.

- Projects estimated greater than \$50,000:
 - Formal bids will be solicited using the Oregon Procurement Information Network (ORPIN), for projects near or anticipated to be valued at \$50,000 or more.
 - Contractors are encouraged to register with ORPIN so they can be watching for these, as well as other ODOT opportunities.

- Projects estimated less than \$50,000:
 - Informal bids will be solicited by geographic location through direct contact with contractors who have registered with the ODOT Small Contracting Program for Construction (available by registering through ORPIN) and/or with the OMWESB program sponsored by the Governor's Advocate office.

- Reporting Requirements
 - Contractors who are awarded "Go Oregon!" projects will be required to complete a form that describes things such as what type of jobs were created and how many workers were employed. The report is a condition of the funding used to pay for the projects, and will be required for payment of invoices.
