Input sought on Transportation Safety Action Plan

People interested in transportation safety issues are invited to share their thoughts and ideas with the Transportation Safety Division of the Oregon Department of Transportation at a meeting on Nov. 18 in John Day. The meeting is scheduled for 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. at the Department of Human Services Conference Room at 725 W Main in John Day. This is one of the first steps the Division is taking as it begins the process of updating the Oregon Transportation Safety Action Plan.

The Oregon Transportation Safety Action Plan is the safety element of the Oregon Transportation Plan, the state's long-range multimodal transportation plan. The Oregon Transportation Safety Action Plan establishes goals, strategies and initiatives that address the core transportation safety challenges and opportunities facing Oregon. The meeting agenda includes:

- An outline of the transportation safety planning process
- An overview of transportation safety related data including statewide data and data specific to the local area.
- A discussion of statewide and local safety challenges and opportunities
