Benefit Fraud or Abuse

(1) Policy Term Violations: An OEGB contracted insurance carrier may remove from coverage and/or deny the claims of an OEGB member due to policy term violations. Violations include but are not limited to fraud, material misrepresentation, or concealment. Removal from coverage due to policy term violations is determined by the insurance carrier.

(2) Eligibility Fraud: OEGB may remove from coverage an OEGB member due to eligibility or enrollment related fraud. Removal from coverage will be retroactive to the date the person has been determined to not longer be eligible.

(A) The member may be responsible for any claims paid during the period of time the member was enrolled inappropriately.

(3) The insurance carrier may do the following when a member has committed fraudulent activity or abusive:

(A) The insurance carrier may retain all premiums paid.

(B) The insurance carrier may deny future enrollments of the individual.
