These rules establish the process for the creation of Individual Development Accounts (IDA) between lower income account holders and authorized fiduciary organizations. The proposed amendments will amend the definition of lower income household and clean up and eliminate redundant language for reports required by the Department.

**Fiscal and Economic Impact:**

There is no expected negative fiscal or economic impact as a result of these amendments. OHCS anticipates positive changes due to restructuring of an income qualifying system which currently does not provide equitable access to the IDA program due to variances in county data.
