Quality Institute (QI) Recommendation 1: An Oregon Quality Institute should be established as a publicly chartered public-private organization. The state should provide stable long-term funding to support the Institute.

QI Recommendation 2: The Quality Institute's overarching role will be to lead Oregon toward a higher performing health care delivery system by initiating, championing and aligning efforts to improve the quality and transparency of health care delivered to Oregonians

QI Recommendation 3: As the budget of the Quality Institute allows, the Quality Institute Board of Directors should use data and evidence to identify opportunities to improve quality and transparency.
