Describe the process for taking back containers from the consumer's perspective (from entering the facility to receiving payment): Customers will have the option (based on quantity of containers) of utilizing RVM's, hand-count by service associate or participating in a drop off service. Regardless of the method, customer will be given the option for cash up to \$10.00 or a check for amounts greater than \$10.00.

14. Projections for number of customers and peak hours of operation: avg. 16 customers per hour / peak hours: 9 – 10am & 5 – 6 pm

15. Brief description of parking facilities to serve the redemption center (include # of spaces): Generous parking available, as parcel is over 24,000 SF, ten spaces around building. Additional spaces under covered area for drop & go service and along the north and west end of building.
