The applicant proposes to provide beverage container redemption services for the following stores:

Albertsons #536, 25691 SE Stark, Troutdale

Gresham Fred Meyer, 2497 NE Burnside, Gresham

Safeway #430, 1455 NE Division, Gresham

WinCo #47, 2511 SE 1st St., Gresham

If the application is approved by OLCC, the redemption center will provide redemption services for bottles, cans and other containers that are subject to an Oregon bottle deposit. Redemption services include accepting returnable cans and bottles and other containers and paying the bottle return fee. This center will accept containers that are subject to the Oregon 5-cent deposit, even if the containers were purchased at other Oregon stores. ***If approved, the stores listed above will no longer take back cans, bottles, or other containers.***

The OLCC will approve a redemption center if it will provide a convenient service to consumers for the return of empty beverage containers. The applicant proposes to be open seven days per week from 9:00 am to 8:00 pm in the summer, and from 9:00 am to 7:00 pm during the rest of the year. The center proposes to accept up to 200 containers per person per day and to make special arrangements to accept larger quantities from fundraiser and donation accounts.

If approved, the redemption center is anticipated to open late summer/early fall. As part of our application process, we are posting this public notice. You can view a copy of the redemption center application at www.oregon.gov/olcc.
