OLCC issues eight proposed license cancellations

PORTLAND, Ore. – The Oregon Liquor Control Commission proposes to cancel the liquor licenses of:

- Center Market #1**, 1765 Center Street, Salem
- Center Market #2**, 216 SW Washington, Dallas
- Center Market #9**, 3401 Third Street, Tillamook
- Center Market #5**, 180 NE Main St., Willamina
- Center Market #6**, 901 Ferry Street, Dayton
- Center Market #12**, 604 Main Street, Tillamook
- Center Market #13**, 4266 Jasper Road, Springfield

The liquor licenses for **Center Market #1, #2 and #9** are held by Bahadur Singh and Parvinder Sindal of Center Market, Inc. Bahadur Singh of Raman, Inc. is the licensee for **Center Market #5 and #6**. The license for **Center Market #12** is held by Bahadur Singh of Amrit, Inc. The licenses are being proposed for cancellation due to Mr. Singh's conviction of a Class C Felony in Marion County Circuit Court for Engaging in Business as a Tobacco Products Distributor without a License and Unlawful Distribution of Tobacco Products.

Soni Singh holds the liquor license for **Center Market #13**. The license is being proposed for cancellation due to Mr. Singh's conviction of a Class C Felony in Marion County Circuit Court for Unlawful Distribution of Tobacco Products. At the time of the conviction, Mr. Singh also held a liquor license at **Center Market #3**, 2797 12th Street SE, Salem.

"Having a liquor license is a privilege," says Linda Ignowski, Director of Regulatory Process. "Our job is to make sure that licensees are selling alcohol responsibly and abiding by state laws. A felony conviction on the premises shows a disregard for the law."

A felony or misdemeanor conviction committed on the licensed premises is a violation of Oregon Revised Statute 471.315(1)(a)(l).

No licensees have requested an administrative hearing. Hearing dates are scheduled by the Office of Administrative Hearings.
