Oregon Winery Acting as a Direct Shipper Frequently Asked Questions

To whom can I ship wine or cider?

You may ship to any legal resident of Oregon, for personal consumption only, and no resale.

Do I need to have a special license?

You need to have an approval letter for direct shipping from OLCC License Division. Contact Lanette Clayton, Application Coordinator, at 503-872-5123.

Do I need a bond?

The bond that you have for your winery will cover direct shipping.

What forms do I need to fill out, and how often?

All reporting will be completed with your current winery privilege tax statements. All information regarding sales of direct shipments must be retained at your place of business for a minimum of two years.

When are the forms due?

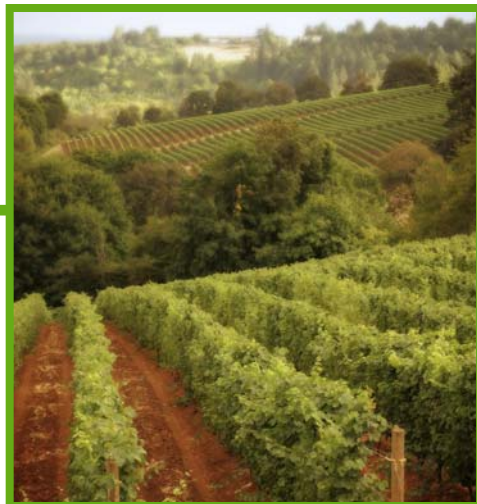
Privilege tax statements are due annually if no tax is due for the year, or monthly if a tax liability exists in any month of the year.

Who is responsible to pay the tax?

The winery that is direct shipping is responsible for paying the tax.

How many cases of wine or cider can I ship to a resident in a month?

You may not ship more than two cases per month, containing not more than nine liters per case.
