False Identification Training Course

This free class is offered to licensees to reduce minors' use of altered or forged driver licenses and identification to purchase alcoholic beverages.

Description

The OLCC provides free instruction to help licensees and their employees recognize false or altered identification. The program fosters a sense of direct participation and satisfaction for licensees in deterring the use of false or altered identification by minors.

In this program, OLCC will:

- Provide an overview of the program and training offered on identification. The training highlights steps for sellers in recognizing false or altered identification, confiscating such identification, and gathering information for follow-up cases.
- Offer training classes for licensees and their employees at all OLCC offices by request.
- Evaluate each case submitted by licensees and issue appropriate citations when possible
- Forward altered or false identification to DMV for license suspension, if the person who presented the identification cannot be located.

Results

OLCC expects to see a reduction in the use of an increase in the number of citations issued for misrepresentation of age, attempting to purchase, use of an invalid license and forgery cases. It also expects to see a reduction in the use of altered and false identification presented to purchase alcoholic beverages, as the program continues over time.
