



## Community Right To Know Secured Information Overview

Some of the information reported by facilities is confidential and secured and cannot be released to the public per ORS 453.332(4). Secured information includes:

- Site-specific storage location of hazardous substances at a facility.
- Emergency contact night phone number.
- Chemicals reported by a facility that have a hazard class code of 1.1, 1.2, 1.3, 1.4, 1.5, 1.6 (explosives); 2.3 (poison gases); 6.2 (etiologic materials); and 7.0 (radioactive materials).
- Hazardous Substance Information Survey (because it most likely contains some of the above listed secured information). The information included on the survey that is not secured can be accessed by requesting a Public Report.

### Requests for Secured Information

Requests for secured information must be submitted on the Hazardous Materials Information Request form. Include how you will use the information. The request will be reviewed by the Data Manager, who will make the final determination on whether the information can be released. If approved, the information is for you only and cannot be shared.

Before receiving secured information, you must:

- Acknowledge that you understand what information is considered confidential.
- Agree to be bound by ORS 453.332(4).

"Site specific information regarding the exact amount and location of a hazardous substance provided to or obtained by the State Fire Marshal or by an agency identified in ORS 453.322 shall be treated by the State Fire Marshal or the agency as confidential."

- Agree not to release any of the confidential information. Secured information must be protected.

Secured information is not included in the searchable substance online database or the public version of the Hazardous Substance Information System software.
