<b>Committee Member Follow-up Questions/Next Steps</b>	
<b>General Feedback/ Suggestions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Create a guide (in plain language and Spanish, other languages in the future) on how to provide public comment. (Look to see what already exists)</li> <li>• Create an FAQ and 1 pager in plain language and Spanish (then other languages) on the UHPGB work</li> <li>• 1 pager summarizing values &amp; principals</li> <li>• Suggestion to categorize all public comment by theme and priorities</li> <li>• Monthly talking points from board sent to committee members</li> <li>• Opportunity to reach out to other state agencies who send out newsletters to see if they can include a UHPGB blurb</li> <li>• Interest in informally talking to communities around the state about the work of the board, outside of any future scheduled events</li> <li>• Continue to discuss how the board and this committee can engage with different sectors of local government</li> </ul>

<b>Additional Resources Needed</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Is there an option to pay stipends to people or organizations that are asked to present their lived experience on community engagement with the CECC? (make sure tied to priority populations in the bill)</li> <li>• Can we have someone present information on other state universal healthcare efforts, specifically Hawaii, and how they tackled community engagement?</li> <li>• Invite pioneers of universal health care in Oregon to present to the committee about barriers ahead and how we can navigate the forks in the road</li> <li>• Should we have a hotline or avenue available for people who want to talk to a human and voice their concerns about the plan?</li> </ul>
<b>Committee Member Follow-up Tasks</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Send staff any additional organizations, entities, CBOs, etc. that should be added to the resource tracker for future CECC outreach</li> <li>• If you are invited to speak about your work with CECC, let staff know so it can be tracked in the engagement tracker and then plan on sharing how it went. (Ensure you are representing yourself as a committee member, not representing the committee).</li> </ul>
<b>Items to be Discussed with Other Committees</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For all committees: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ What does your committee need from the CECC to support their work and have it communicated out</li> <li>○ Keep the CECC in the know about any timelines where communication materials will be needed to allow for lingual and plain language translation</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
