1'-42'-00" (MIN GLIDE SLOPE= 3.25°)





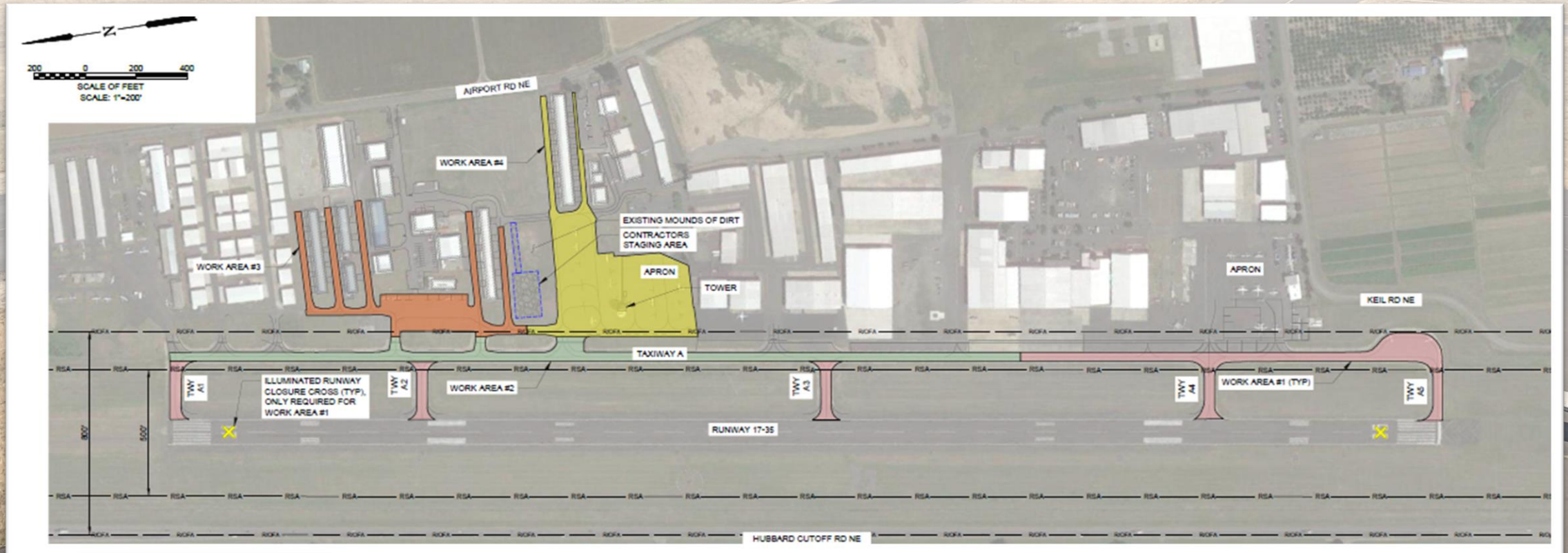

Surface Incident Mitigation - Update



- 1 V/PD and 0 Runway Incursions since last meeting (4/24/2024)
- Continuing work with airport groups on outreach, education, and improvements to mitigate V/PDs from state and private property
- ODAV is creating driver training for state property and movement area access
- FAA recommendations received 2/13

Surface Incident Mitigation – Rule Update

- Public Comments
 - Ended November 11th 2022
- Public Hearing Held
 - October 20th, 2022
- **Final rulemaking will be brought to the Board in June, to coincide with implementation of the drivers training program**

Public comments for the proposed rules are open until 5pm on October 21.
