Commercial UAS Insurance

 Require all Commercial UAS Operations (Part 107, Part 135, Part 91 Under Exemption) Taking off or landing withing the State of OR to have liability insurance that covers aviation at a min. of \$500K

5% Surcharge on UAS Policy

Commercial UAS Insurance

- The Numbers
- \$750 Average Policy (5% = \$37.50)
 - 9,637 Pilots in Oregon
 - \$361,387/YEAR



- Funds Used For
- New AAM Program
- Support Regulation & Safety of Drone Operation
 - Development of Drone Technology, Workforce, Infrastructure
- Travel, Conferences, Marketing, & Various Admin Costs

- Software-Aircraft Registration & Airport Licensing
 - \$70,460 OF
