

Oregon Energy Efficiency Specialty Code 2024 edition

The 2024 Oregon Energy Efficiency Specialty Code (OEESC) is based on the 2022 edition of the ASHRAE Standard 90.1, which was published Jan. 25, 2023.

Rulemaking	March 20, 2024	Public rulemaking hearing The division will hold a public meeting where interested parties can provide testimony about the proposed code provisions.
