RE: 183.403 Agency report to Legislative Assembly regarding rules.

House Bill 4106 (2016) directs state agencies to report annually on their rulemaking actions during the previous year. In 2024 the Board processed no temporary rulemaking amendments. Clarify that in determining which offenders are eligible for a Sexually Violent Dangerous Offender Designation (SVDO), the term "offender" includes adults in custody. Under the Board's definitions, "offender" means: "Any person under the supervision of the Department of Corrections or a local supervisory authority who is not presently in the custody of a correctional facility, including persons on probation, parole or post-prison supervision." When determining SVDO status, a person may be an adult in the custody of a correctional facility.
