Price Agreements – What are they?

A "Price Agreement" is a master agreement for the procurement of products or services at agreed upon terms. They can be used by all State Agencies and most local governments (OrCPPs). Price Agreements benefit agencies by obtaining price discounts and leveraging other concessions through volume purchases. Developed by DAS State Procurement Services*.

Also called:

- Master Blanket Purchase Orders (MBPOs in OregonBuys)
- Blankets (in OregonBuys)
- Statewide Price Agreements
- Price Agreements
- Participating Addendum
- Master Agreements



Price Agreements – What are the benefits?

- They are already competitively solicited and awarded.
 - Subject Matter Experts have been involved in their development
 - Terms and Conditions are set
 - Negotiations are done
 - Risks and Warranties have been considered
- They save time and resources





Who can use them? (Authorized Purchasers – APs)

- State Agencies
- Independent Agencies
- ORCPP members

Check the Price Agreement language.




OREGON COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM (ORCPP)

Eligible entities include:

- Units of local government cities, counties, school districts, etc.
- Special districts fire, water, vector control, health, etc.
- Oregon university and community colleges
- Oregon Forward Contractors
- Confederated Tribes and agencies of Confederated Tribes
- Qualified non-profit entities



The contract view in Marketplace – 3 Available Formats OREGON



Informational

- General Contract Information
- How to purchase from the contract
- Who to contact in order to purchase

Itemized

- Individual Items w/ details (photos, pricing, etc.)
- Buyers can add to cart / export cart

Punchout

- Connect to Vendor's 3rd-Party ecommerce site
- Products and Services display that are specific to the contract.







OrCPP and State Agencies: Some Differences

	OrCPP	State Agencies
What PAs/Blankets are viewable	Oregon Forward, Oregon Corrections Enterprises, Statewide Price Agreements	Oregon Forward, Oregon Corrections Enterprises, Statewide Price Agreements, Agency Specific Price Agreements,
Ordering from Price Agreements	Order outside of OregonBuys through the Contractor	Release from an MBPO (Master Blanket Purchase Order)
Marketplace	Limited to viewing products/services and details. Order outside of Marketplace	Allows viewing products/services and details. Some contracts are enabled to allow ordering through catalogs or "punchouts" Efforts are underway to increase catalog options.
Governance	Statute, May use DOJ Procurement Rules, Local Contract Review Board, School Board Rules, etc.	Statute, Agency rules, most use DAS Procurement Rules including the Buy Decision
