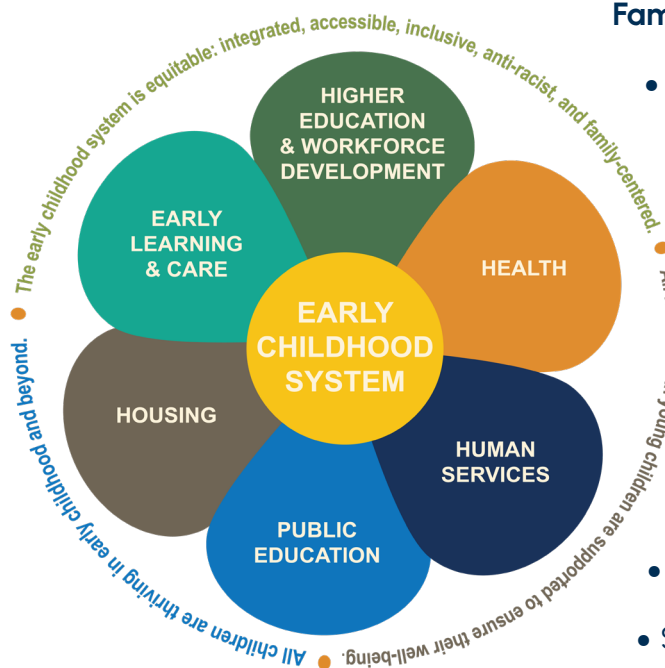


# The New Raise Up Oregon Early Childhood System Plan is Ready to Read
