### Roles and Responsibilities Matrix

#### **OTELA (Advisory Body)**

Need to define purpose, membership, services, activities for statute

More programmatic
Design and monitor implementation of a
tribal early learning plan
Some may flow up to the subcommittee/full
cluster

Makes sure that DELC is on-track, work with DELC staff (specifically the Office of Tribal Affairs)

Includes subject matter experts (to include AI/AN providers/educators in community), community members, other agencies

#### **Gov-to-Gov Education Subcommittee**

Will not codify in role statute, defined by SB 770

#### **Temporary\***

Tribes will select members

Issues can be elevated up from the subcommittee to ed cluster – vetting the issues for elevation for a different level, i.e. system challenges

More broad wishes for the future Work on POPs, plans for next biennium

\*G2G Ed Cluster Subcommittees have always been timelimited. Subcommittee would be in place between 9/2024-9/2025, once OTELA is stood up. After that, will use the clusters as appropriate.

## Early Learning Subcommittee

The subcommittee's purpose is to advise DELC on the development of the Tribal Early Learning Plan and Fund, prior to the establishment of the Oregon Tribal Early Learning Alliance (pending legislation). The committee will provide guidance, input, advocacy and recommendations on policy, rules, and legislation related to the Tribal Early Learning Plan. The subcommittee will recommend goals and measurable objectives which aim to meet the needs of AI/AN children and their families and are culturally inclusive and responsive of Tribal communities.
