Tribal Funding Needs

Funding Amounts:

- How much funding does each Tribe think they could spend in the 2025-2027 biennium?
- Responses received
 - Total request: \$4.5M (\$500k/tribe)

Funding Distribution:

- In the past, equal distribution was used
- Each Tribe's funding needs and capacity vary regarding needs for the Tribal Early Learning Fund
- Doesn't need to be permanent, can readjust in future biennia (back to equal distribution, formula) or continue as needs-based



Draft Language Update

All changes requested were incorporated successfully:

- 1. Plan Child is used rather than plan student
- 2. Definition for "caregiver" added:
 - Caregiver: an individual who provides ongoing care to a plan child)
- 3. Additional flexibility in Strategies by adding:
 - e. Achieve any other outcomes identified by rule by the council in consultation with the nine federally recognized Indian tribes in Oregon.
- 4. OTELA membership allows for parent or caregiver of plan children
- 5. Chair structure removed from statute
 - Can do this in rule

Roles and Responsibilities

OTELA (Advisory Body)

Need to define purpose, membership, services, activities for statute

More programmatic
Design and monitor implementation of a
tribal early learning plan
Some may flow up to the subcommittee/full
cluster

Makes sure that DELC is on-track, work with DELC staff (specifically the Office of Tribal Affairs)

Includes subject matter experts (to include AI/AN providers/educators in community), community members, other agencies
