
# Using DEQ Air Quality Permits Online Tips on Searching the DEQ Online Database for AQ Permits

Facilities that have been issued air quality permits from DEQ are required to always keep a copy of the permit onsite. These permits are also available online, along with other documents, at <u>AQ Permits Online</u>. Some of the documents you may find include:

- Permits (Including Notices of Intent to Construct and Area Source Registrations)
- Review Reports
- Emissions Detail Sheets
- Permit Modifications and Administrative Amendments
- Annual and Semiannual Reports
- Air Toxics Emissions Inventories
- General Permit Assignment Sheets

## **Air Quality Permits Online basics**

The <u>AQ Permits Online search page</u> provides PDFs of all the documents listed above. This is accessible to anyone at DEQ and members of the public. You can search for a facility by the name or by the permit number in addition to a few other search options.



### **Searching inside a PDF**

All PDFs on AQ Permits Online are scanned with optical character recognition, so they are searchable documents. Once you have opened a file, press Control-F to search for a keyword.
