SFFC FIRE SCHOOL

In the past few weeks, South Fork Forest Camp has successfully trained over 120 AICs through an intensive Fire School program.

The participants underwent a weeklong training covering Incident Command Systems, Human Factors in Wildland Fires, and Environmental Fire Behavior. The training then transitioned to hands-on exercises where AICs practiced responding to real-life fire scenarios.

South Fork alone represents half of the state's ODF-led AIC Wildland Fire Suppression Crews and is already optimistic about achieving great success in the 2024 Fire Season.
