The Oregon Department of Corrections Health Services continues to prepare for the new Electronic Health Records (EHR) System.

It is DOC Health Services' priority to keep your family member's private health information safe as we transition paper health records to electronic health records. When paper records are scanned, the electronic files are stored, backed-up, and protected on hard drives, and can only be accessed by authorized people in health services who take care of your family member's health.

The privacy rules in place at DOC also makes sure that your family member's health information stays confidential!
