

# Required Professional Development for Year 3 Burlington English Implementation

In Year 3, Oregon will move away from professional development that focuses on "What is BE and how does the platform work?" to professional development that focuses on "How does my program use BE effectively and creatively to improve student outcomes?" To do this, professional development will focus on localized, whole-program professional development sessions that foster a consistent vision for each program and create space for program-wide collaboration. Sessions will be informed by local program data and based on local program needs.

## Burlington School Kickoff

Daphne and/or Marisa can be onsite for a day/evening, set up in a shared area (such as a teacher's lounge) to answer individual teacher questions and work 1:1 with teachers to help them use the BE curriculum components effectively. Short visits to classrooms may also be possible during this time.

## Onsite or Virtual PD Follow up

Once the required whole staff PD is completed, additional onsite/virtual PD can be scheduled with Marisa and Daphne and can be used to fulfill sessions 2 and 3 of the HECC's PLC requirement.

Daphne or Marisa will attend your class or computer lab to provide a Student Orientation, assist with student log in, and help students download the app.
