2	Pursuant to ORS 197.830(13)(b) and OAR 661-010-0021, the City of St.
3	Helens withdrew the decision challenged in this appeal for reconsideration on
4	January 2, 2024. On May 13, 2024, the Board received the city decision on
5	reconsideration. Pursuant to OAR 661-010-0021(5)(a), petitioners had until June
6	3, 2024, to either refile their original notice of intent to appeal in this matter, or
7	file an amended notice of intent to appeal. The Board has not received a refiled
8	original notice of intent to appeal or an amended notice of intent to appeal in
9	accordance with OAR 661-010-0021(5)(a).
10	OAR 661-010-0021(5)(e) provides "[i]f no amended notice of intent to
11	appeal is filed or no original notice of intent to appeal is refiled, as provided in
12	[OAR 661-010-0021(5)(a)], the appeal will be dismissed."
