21	MOTIONS TO INTERVENE		
22	R. James Claus, Keith Howe and	Lawrence James Ernster separately move to	
23	intervene on the side of respondent in this appeal. There is no opposition to the motions, and		
24	they are allowed.		
25	MOTION TO STAY APPEAL PROCEEDINGS		
26	Petitioner moves for an order staying this appeal pending mediation. ORS 197.860		
27	provides, in part:		
28 29 30 31	"All parties to an appeal may at any time prior to a final decision by the Court of Appeals under ORS 197.855 stipulate that the appeal proceedings be stayed for any period of time agreeable to the parties and the board or court to allow the parties to enter mediation." (Emphasis added.)		
32	Respondent joins in petitioner's request, however, intervenors-respondent do not. Intervenors		
33	respondent Claus expressly opposes the motion, noting that he has not been made a party to		
34	the requested mediation.		

1	Under ORS 197.860 "[a]ll parties" must "stipulate" that an appeal be suspended to	
2	allow the "parties" to enter mediation. Intervenor's-respondent are parties in this appeal.	
3	OAR 661-010-0050(1); Ramsey v. City of Portland, 22 Or LUBA 295, 301-06 (1991).	
4	Intervenors-respondent do not stipulate that this appeal should be suspended to allow	
5	mediation and apparently petitioner and respondent have not invited intervenors-respondent	
6	to participate in such mediation. Accordingly the motion to suspend this appeal is denied.1	
7	MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF BRIEFING SCHEDULE	
8	The local record in this appeal was received by the Board on January 29, 1999. The	
9	petition for review is due February 19, 1999. OAR 660-010-0030(1). On February 11, 1999.	
10	petitioner filed a motion requesting that the deadline for filing the petition for review be	
11	extended from February 19, 1999, to March 22, 1999, and that respondent's brief be due	
12	April 12, 1999. Any request to extend the deadline for filing the petition for review under	
13	OAR 661-010-067(2) must be signed by all parties, including intervenors-respondent	
14	Ramsey, 22 Or LUBA at 305-06. Intervenors-respondent do not join in the request that the	
15	briefing schedule be extended, and, for that reason, the motion is denied.
