Commodity Movement Guidance

DAIRY CATTLE, SEMEN, OR EMBRYOS

Product Description


Cattle, and semen or embryos from cattle, that are raised for milk production.

Requirements to be Met Prior to Movement

- ☐ Traceability information is available (national premises identification number [PIN], GPS Coordinates, and information on type and number of animals/quantity of semen/embryos to be moved).
- ☐ Biosecurity measures listed in the appropriate biosecurity checklist (see sub-bullet) are in place and acceptable to Responsible Regulatory Officials.
 - Self-assessment checklist for enhanced biosecurity for FMD prevention: dairy¹
- ☐ Trace-back/forward information is acceptable (premises is not Infected, Suspect, or Contact).
 - Producers can provide trace-back and trace-forward information by maintaining accurate records of
 movement of animals, feed, supplies, equipment, personnel, and visitors. Producers can use the Secure Milk
 Supply (SMS) Plan <u>Practice Questionnaire for FMD Exposure</u>² to get a feel for the information they may need
 to provide in an outbreak.
- ☐ Destination premises and State are willing to accept the cattle/semen/embryos.
- ☐ No evidence of infection based on disease monitoring (surveillance).
