Commodity Movement Guidance

GOATS AND GOAT SEMEN, EMBRYOS, OR OTHER PRODUCTS

Product Description


Goats, and semen or embryos or other products from goats, that are raised for brush control/pack goat services, meat, or milk. (Mohair/cashmere are included in a separate commodity movement guidance document.)

Requirements to be Met Prior to Movement

- ☐ Traceability information is available (national premises identification number [PIN], GPS Coordinates, and information on type and number of animals/quantity of semen/embryos/product to be moved).
- ☐ Biosecurity measures listed in the appropriate Biosecurity Checklist (see sub-bullets) are in place and acceptable to Responsible Regulatory Officials.
 - Self-assessment checklist for enhanced biosecurity for FMD prevention: goat operations¹
- ☐ Epidemiology information is acceptable.
 - Producers can provide epidemiological information by maintaining accurate records of movement of animals, feed, supplies, equipment, personnel, and visitors. Producers can use the Secure Sheep and Wool Supply (SSWS) Plan <u>Practice Questionnaire for FMD Exposure</u>² to get a feel for the information they may need to provide in an outbreak.
- ☐ Destination premises and State are willing to accept the animals, semen, embryos, or product(s).
- □ No evidence of infection based on disease monitoring (surveillance).
