Commodity Movement Guidance

RAW MILK

Product Description


Raw milk is milk from dairy cattle that has not been pasteurized to kill harmful pathogens.

Requirements to be Met Prior to Movement

- ☐ Traceability information is available (national premises identification number [PIN], GPS Coordinates, and identification information on truck/tanker moved).
- ☐ Biosecurity measures as described in the Biosecurity Performance Standards for raw milk collection and transport and appropriate Secure Milk Supply plan permit guidance documents (see sub-bullets) are in place for origin premises, milk hauler(s), and receiving/processing plant(s) and are acceptable to Responsible Regulatory Officials.
 - Biosecurity Performance Standards (BPS) Raw Milk¹
 - o Permitting guidance for managed milk movement of raw milk Regulatory Officials²
 - Permitting guidance for managed milk movement of raw milk Milk Processor³
- ☐ Dairy operation is not designated as Infected, Suspect, or Contact Premises.
- ☐ Destination premises and State are willing to accept the milk.
- □ No evidence of infection based on disease monitoring (surveillance).
- ☐ Truck route to processing is acceptable to Responsible Regulatory Officials (if applicable).
- ☐ All interstate movements meet normal movement requirements in addition to outbreak specific conditions.
