SHIPPING PERMITS/CERTIFICATES- NEW

We provide shipping permits, certifying that trees have been inspected and found free of injurious pests and diseases of concern. The permits are now being issued electronically as a PDF that will be emailed to you by your ODA inspector. You may print/copy this permit to include in your shipments just as you would the stickers that have been issued previously.

Should you wish to receive the booklet (50 stickers per booklet) for the type of certificates you need, please contact your ODA inspector to request.

Type of certification:

- Christmas Tree Shipping Permits
- Brown Garden Snail Certificates
 - Required for Christmas tree shipments to: AL, AR, FL, MS, NC, TN, and WV
- European Pine Shoot Moth Certificates
 - Required for shipping pine Christmas trees to California. Only pines from fields that have a negative trapping history for pine shoot moth are eligible.

EXPORTING CHRISTMAS TREES

Christmas trees shipped out of the continental United States usually require an inspection and phytosanitary certification prior to shipping, and may also require a pre-harvest field inspection. If you plan to export Christmas trees to Mexico, Hawaii, Japan, Puerto Rico, or other foreign destinations, please complete the section on the following page:
