Voluntary Recall of Dacthal Products by AMVAC

For all pesticide dealers, please see the attached letters from AMVAC regarding their voluntary recall of Dacthal Flowable Herbicide (EPA Registration No. 5481-487).

As a reminder, on August 06, 2024, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued an Emergency Order suspending all registrations of pesticides containing DCPA, marketed under the trade name Dacthal. EPA has determined that a suspension order is necessary to prevent an imminent hazard to human health. No person may distribute, sell, or use any pesticide containing DCPA.

As a reminder, on August 06, 2024, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued an Emergency Order suspending all registrations of pesticides containing DCPA, marketed under the trade name Dacthal. EPA has determined that a suspension order is necessary to prevent an imminent hazard to human health. No person may distribute, sell, or use any pesticide containing DCPA.

Distribution of DCPA products for the sole purpose of returning the products to the registrant is allowed. Please see the letters from AMVAC for questions regarding product returns and disposal.
