  - 1. What is the workload impact if many of the categories are not part of the initial recommendation proposal process?
  - 2. Good idea to identify outcomes (short and long term) up front.
  - 3. Helpful to have alignment to SIA priorities and district goals.
- c. Implication for DOME TOSA
  - i. Generative Brainstorm → Narrowed Focus
    - 1. No new information to share at this point in time.
    - 2. Position will be moving to a school based coaching model.
  - ii. What are one or two high leverage data points that could (or are already collected) that align to these outcomes?

- 1. Question: Has the DOME TOSA job description changed? No.
- 2. Question: Will the success metrics change when the position moves to a school based model? Frank will meet with the TOSAs regularly to calibrate. Being centrally positioned, it created a barrier to developing the trust and relationship needed to enter into a coaching relationship.
- 3. Question: "DOME TOSAs will collaborate and train..." How many other TOSAs/coaches will remain next year to keep this as a metric? Not many aside from SPED TOSAs will remain next year.
  - a. Remove/rephrase this language from the metrics to reflect more school based work.
- 4. Emphasis on educating staff on language acquisition. Wei-Wei offered to collaborate with Frank when meeting with DOME TOSAs.
  - a. Idea: After school series/workshop around language acquisition for staff.

### 4. Recommendations (as needed)

- a. High School Activity Funding (FC/CT)
  - i. Frank and Cayle are exploring "how to make our high schools fee free" (athletics and activities)
    - 1. Shared current athletic and activities fee table.
    - 2. Problem solving: how to make up the revenue loss from not collecting fees?
    - 3. Currently no participation fees for band, choir, orchestra, theatre, speech & debate.
    - 4. Current funding for fine arts
    - 5. District currently pays for students who make it to state.
    - 6. Programs will continue to fundraise. This will not replace fundraising.
    - Estimated cost ~100,000/annually and much smaller amount at Reynolds Learning Academy.
    - 8. Frank will collaborate with Cayle on this recommendation.
    - 9. Connect this recommendation to how it contributes to graduation rates and reducing chronic absenteeism.
    - 10. Next Steps: Need numbers from high schools
    - 11. Next Steps: Use new recommendation proposal template.
