Deep Dive Session #5 Outcomes

Practical Outcomes

- Gain an understanding of the current accountability ecosystem and the ways in which ODE holds districts accountable.

Cultivating the Space



- **Trust** is earned and let's attempt to move in conversation like we've got several years working together already behind us.
- Engage tension, don't indulge drama.
- Listen to your gut!
- **Share** space help collectively balance the insights of verbal and quick processors with the wisdom of those who might appear more reticent.
- **Confidentiality** this is not a social-media space. Lessons can be shared but leave the details.
- **Dialogue**, not selling let's converse not pitch.
- Assume best intent, attend to impact.
- Pay attention (neighbors, yourself, group process and dynamics).
- We are committed to centering children and families.

ODE Level Continuum of Supports for Improvement



- <u>Technical Assistance</u> is focused and responsive support for school districts and ESDs.
- **<u>Professional Development</u>** includes learning opportunities on critical topics.
- <u>Coaching</u> is a sustained and customizable learning program specifically for individual districts.
- <u>Corrective Action</u> is when ODE determines actions that must be completed in order to maintain funding eligibility and compliance with state or federal law.
 - ODE understands that holding these responsibilities with integrity means providing clear expectations, offering excellent support, and being thoughtful about what remedies are required to have the most positive impact on students, educators, and communities.
