Validation Window for SEED Survey is Open; Data are Preliminary

The preliminary data for the Student Educational Equity Development (SEED) Survey have been uploaded to the ADI. Districts are encouraged to check their results before the validation window closes at the end of September. Note: Until the validation window closes, SEED data should be treated as *preliminary*. Do not share the data publicly. Also, a refresh of the data using the final spring membership numbers will occur before the end of August; districts might notice a slight change in their data after the refresh.
