Q1: I have a tutor who wants to know where to access OSAS practice tests to help students prepare. She does not have a district ID or account, so will need something that the public can access.

A: Sample tests can be publicly accessed on the OSAS portal. Please use this link.

Q2: Is there a way we can either obtain or create demo data in order to create tutorials?

A: You can work with ODE staff to obtain demo data. <u>Andrew Byerley</u> (Mathematics Assessment Specialist), <u>Tony Bertrand</u> (ELA & Social Sciences Assessment Specialist), and <u>Mariela Salas-Bao</u> (Science Assessment Specialist) have access to demo data in CRS, and they can work with you to develop training materials.

Q3: Are exemplars available before the students take the test so we can teach using them before they take the test?

A: The exemplars are not available prior to testing. They are designed for use by a team of teachers to calibrate scoring, not necessarily for student use PRIOR to testing. They could be useful AFTER testing to display examples of student work and to have students practice scoring and/or using a rubric.

Q4: How would I know what date a student tested?

A: You can download an Individual Student Report (ISR) or a Student Data file from CRS to see the date the student tested.
